


To avoid damaging this product, assemble it on a soft, non-abrasive surface such as carpet or cardboard.



Assembly

1 Removing the old large fabric cover and the small fabric cover


- □ Remove the large fabric cover (K) from the beams (A) and the panels (B) by unfastening the Velcro.
- □ Remove the small fabric cover (J) from the short tubes of the canopy spokes (D).
- □ Remove the large fabric cover (K) from the assembled frame.



Assembly (continued)

2 Attaching the new large fabric cover and the small fabric cover

- Place the large fabric cover (K) onto the assembled frame.
- Place the small fabric cover (J) and secure each corner by fully extending the fabric to the assembled short tubes of the canopy spokes (D).
- Fully extend the large fabric cover (K) and tie it to the beams (A) and the panels (B) by affixing the Velcro.



Care and Cleaning

- For best results, clean the canopy with a damp cloth, and dry the frames thoroughly. This will help prevent mildew by removing dirt particles that may accumulate.
- Do not clean with abrasive materials, bleach, or solvents.
- Store the canopy in a dry, sheltered place when not in use.
- Keep the canopy away from fire, extreme heat, freezing conditions, and inclement weather such as rain, hail, sleet, snow, or wind.
