

Care and Cleaning

- Do not overtighten connectors (screws, bolts, etc.).

- Be sure to check all packing materials carefully for small parts that may have come loose inside the carton during shipment. If parts are missing, contact THE HOME DEPOT to obtain any missing parts.
- DO NOT USE SUBSTITUTE PARTS.
- This product should only be used on a flat, level surface.
- Some assembly may involve attaching glass or mirrors.
- Be very careful handling the glass or mirrors, as severe injury may result if the glass or mirror breaks.



PLANNING ASSEMBLY

- $\hfill\square$ Remove all Packaging materials , staples and packing straps form the carton .
- n Refer to Parts List and Hardware List , and ensure parts and hardware are correct before assembly .
- Contact customer service for missing parts.
- Place all wooden parts on a clean , flat , and soft surface (e.g.carpet or rug) to prevent scratch and damage to parts .






Locked cam bolt(AA) to top panel(A) and attached wooden dowel(CC) to bottom panel (E) as shown




2 Locked cam bolt(AA) to drawer front panel(F) and layer box(D), then attached wooden dowel(CC) to layer box(D) and divider panel(C) as shown




3 Locked cam bolt(AA) and attached wooden dowel(CC) to side panel(B)




4 Connect layer box(D) to side panel(B) with cam lock(BB) as shown




4 Connect bottom panel(E) with cam lock(BB) from step 3




 $5\,$ Connect side panel(B) with cam lock(BB) from step 4 $\,$




6 Connect divider panel(C) with cam lock(BB) from step 5



Connect table top panel(A) with cam lock(BB) from step 6 as shown




8 Locked cam bolt(AA) to drawer front panel(F),connect side panel(G) to drawer front panel(F) with cam lock(BB),then insert drawer bottom panel(H),connect drawer front panel(F) with cam lock(BB),assembly knob(FF) with screw(EE) as shown

Maintenance

- $\hfill\square$ Keep the product away from direct heat and sunlight .
- $\hfill\square$ \hfill Prolonged exposure to heat sources may cause scorching, or even cause color to fade .
- □ Regular vacuuming or light brushing helps to remove dirt and prevent soil build-up, which increases the appearance of wear .
- Deriodically (every 90 days) make sure that the screws arefully tightened .

Care and Cleaning

- □ Handle with care.
- $\hfill\square$ Use a slightly damp cloth to clean the product. Do not use bleach or use abrasive cleaning material .
- □ Check all the fittings periodically and re-tighten as necessary. Do not us the product if any of the parts are damaged or broken .
- □ Never allow any kind of liquid to remain on your furniture .
- $\hfill\square$ Absorption can make wood wrap or delaminate .
- $\hfill\square$ Do not place hot items (e.g. hot drinks) directly onto the wood surface.
- \square Do not drag and /or pull the furniture .
- □ Never use harsh chemicals or solvents on your product as this may damage the metal .
- □ Marks and stains from pens, crayons and ink markers are difficult to remove. In the event that your products become permanently stained, we recommend that you consult a professional.
