



This product is made of aluminum. Do not use power tools above 8 volts to assemble and only tighten bolts until snug. Over tightening can damage the aluminum.





Place Top (A) upside down on a soft cloth.

Insert Bolts into pre-drilled holes in Top (A), then tighten. (See Figure 2)

Attach unit to Top (A) with Flat Washers, Spring Washers and Nuts, tightening Nuts only halfway.

Tighten all Nuts used in Steps 1 and 2.

Cover all Nuts with Caps.




