

Care & Maintenance

Although this unit does not require any maintenance, care should be taken to prolong the life of your shed.

ROOF: Keep roof clean of leaves and snow with long handled, soft bristled broom. Heavy amounts of snow on the roof can damage the shed making it unsafe. **Do not step on the roof.**

WALLS: Do not rest any object against the wall panels of the shed.

DOORS: Keep doors closed to prevent wind damage.

FASTENERS : Regularly check your shed for loose screws, bolts, nuts, etc. And retighten them as necessary.

MOISTURE: With changing temperatures, condensation will accumulate inside the shed. Good ventilation will help in regulating and avoid moisture.

TIP: A noncorrosive caulking is helpful to seal the shed.

CLEANING

The Duramax steel panels are stain- and solvent-resistant. Most stains can be removed, using a mild soap and a soft-bristled brush. Abrasive cleaning materials may scratch the metal and are not recommended.

Repair scratches or rust spots on the metal by sanding the affected area lightly; using a rust preventative spray primer; and finally, spraying with a high-gloss spray enamel paint.

Avoid placing a direct heat source on or near surfaces unless using a heat barrier.
