Ladder Operating Procedure and Safety Instructions

For safety, inspect ladder before use. Never use ladder with missing, worn or damaged parts.

Specifications

1) INSPECTION

INSPECT BEFORE EACH USE.
NEVER CLIMB A DAMAGED,
BENT, OR BROKEN STEP
STOOL; ALL WORKING PARTS
MUST BE IN GOOD WORKING
ORDER.

KEEP STEP STOOL CLEAN,
FREE FROM GREASE, OIL, MUD,
SNOW, WET PAINT AND OTHER
SLIPPERY MATERIAL. KEEP
YOUR SHOES CLEAN. LEATHER
SOLES SHOULD NOT BE USED.

DESTROY STEPS IF BROKEN,
WORN OR IF EXPOSED TO FIRE
OR CHEMICAL CORROSION.

2) SET-UP

PLACE ON FIRM, STABLE, LEVEL
SURFACE FOOTING. DO NOT
USE ON SLIPPERY SURFACE.

DO NOT PLACE ON BOX,
UNSTABLE BASES OR
SCAFFOLDS TO GAIN
ADDITIONAL HEIGHT. DO NOT
PLACE IN FRONT OF DOOR
OPENING TOWARD STEP STOOL.

3) PROPER USE

DO NOT USE STEP STOOL IF YOU
TIRE EASILY, ARE SUBJECT TO
FAINTING SPELLS, ARE USING
MEDICINE OR ALCOHOL OR ARE
PHYSICALLY IMPAIRED.

TO PROTECT CHILDREN, DO NOT
LEAVE STEP STOOL SET UP AND
UNATTENDED.

FACE STEP STOOL WHEN
CLIMBING UP OR DOWN; KEEP
BODY CENTERED BETWEEN SIDE
RAILS.

DO NOT OVER REACH; MOVE
STEP STOOL WHEN NEEDED.
DO NOT "WALK" OR "JOG" STEP
STOOL WHEN STANDING ON IT.

CARRY TOOLS IN TOOLBELT
HOLSTER OR POUCH, NOT IN
YOUR HANDS.

DO NOT FOLD AND LEAN ON
THE LADDER AGAINST A
SURFACE.

FULLY OPEN AND LOCK LEGS
WITH FOUR LEGS ON SOLID
SURFACE.

3) PROPER USE (con't)

DO NOT OVERLOAD. STEP
STOOLS ARE MEANT FOR ONE
PERSON. DO NOT USE AS
BRACE, PLATFORM OR PLANK.

KEEP STEP STOOL CLOSE TO
WORK; AVOID PUSHING OR
PULLING OFF TO THE SIDE OF
STEP STOOL.

TOP OF LADDER SHOULD
NEVER BE USED AS A STEP.

BRACE YOURSELF WITH YOUR
FREE HAND IF POSSIBLE.

4) STORAGE

STORE STEP STOOL IN SAFE
AND DRY PLACE.

NEVER STORE MATERIALS ON
STEP STOOL.

KEEP STEP STOOL CLEAN AND
FREE OF FOREIGN MATERIALS.

KEEP AWAY FROM CHILDREN.
