Before You Start


- IPT Sink Company recommends that all ceramic sinks be installed by an experienced, professional installer.
- IMPORTANT: The enclosed cutout template is only for reference. It is recommended that you discuss with your installer and agree that the finished appearance is the desired effect. IPT Sink Company is not responsible for improper sink or countertop installations.
- IMPORTANT: The cabinet must be installed, secured, plumb, and level. Failure of this step can lead to product damage.
- IPT Sink Company ceramic sinks should only be fastened to a solid surface countertop (i.e. granite, Corian® or Silestone®).
- IPT Sink Company is not responsible for sink or countertop if damaged during installation. Be sure to inspect the sink for damage prior to beginning installation.
- Follow all local plumbing and building codes.



- 1. Unpack the new sink and check the contents of the materials supplied: sink, and cutout template.
- 2. Place the sink upside down in desired position on the countertop and trace completely around the edge of the sink.
- 3. Use the cutout template as reference. Position it to the proper place that in between the sink edge line and trace around the edge of the template.



- 4. Drill a pilot hole in all four corners of the inside line. Use a saber saw or jig saw to cut on the inside line. (Note: Place a support underneath the cutout portion of the countertop to prevent it from falling during cutting.)
- 5. Apply silicone sealant (not included) around the cutout on the countertop surface.
- 6. Carefully lower the sink into the cutout in the countertop.
- 7. Wipe away any excess sealant with a rag. (Note: It is recommended that keep sealant dry for several hours before install the drain and other supplement in case of moving the sink.)



SUGGESTED MAINTENANCE

- Wash your sink using warm water, a non-abrasive liquid cleaner or detergent and a soft cloth or non-abrasive woven nylon pad. Your sink may be cleaned as often as it is used.
- For daily cleaning, a warm water soaked sponge with mild soap followed by warm water rinse is recommended. Drying the sink afterwards with a soft cloth or towel will help to eliminate water spots and maintain shine.
- For deeper cleaning needs, a product such as Bar Keeper's Friend or porcelain safe bathroom cleaner is ideal followed by a thorough rinse and soft cloth or towel drying. For a greener clean, try baking soda.
- Always read cleaning product labels to confirm their recommended usage as well as warnings and cautions.
- Note that these recommendations are for the porcelain only and do not refer to the faucet, drain, or other hardware.
- Rinse thoroughly after each use. Most soaps and detergents contain chlorides that are harsh on porcelain. Chlorides are highly water soluble so a thorough rinsing of your sink after each use and weekly cleaning will keep your sink looking bright and shiny.
- Towel dry after each use to prevent mineral deposits from building upon the surface of the sink. Water quality can affect the appearance of your sink. Towel drying and weekly cleaning will prevent discoloration or unsightly film from developing on the finish.
- Read the labels on cleaning products to confirm they are recommended for use on porcelain.
- Harsh chemicals contained in some cleaning products can permanently damage the porcelain.

WHO IS COVERED BY THE WARRANTY

This warranty applies to the original purchaser for the original installation only.

WHAT IS COVERED BY THE WARRANTY: Porcelain, Fireclay and Copper Sinks

IPT Sink Company will replace without charge (excluding labor), any Porcelain, Fireclay or Copper sink that is proven to be defective, with an equivalent replacement, within the specified appropriate period from date of purchase, to the original purchaser, provided it has been used solely in a residential application, used and cleaned as recommended and not damaged due to abuse, misuse or negligence. In the event of a warranty claim, the owner will be required to provide proof of purchase (please save the sales receipt).

CONDITIONS AND EXCLUSIONS

This warranty will not cover any damages that might be caused by the product. (Some states do not allow such limitation, so this reference may not apply to you.)

IPT Sink Company reserves the right to inspect any sink reported to be defective prior to any replacement of the sink. All decisions are final. Replacement cost EXCLUDES transportation and any labor costs for the removal or re-installation.

Grid, Strainer and other accessories are specifically excluded from this warranty.

The manufacturer shall not be liable in case of:

- Improper installation/modification
- Damages resulting from abuse, such as heavy impact or dropped objects
- Improper care and maintenance
- Improper application (such as exposure to corrosive chemicals, photographic solutions, etc.)
- Any modification made to the product after it left our premises
- Commercial application

NON-APPLICABILITY OF THIS WARRANTY

This Warranty supersedes all other warranties, expressed or implied.
