

### **Safety Information**

- 1. Read all instructions carefully before you begin this installation.

**CAUTION:** Do not plug or unplug the puck lights from the connection box while power is on.

**CAUTION:** Do not dismantle or alter this fixture. There are no user serviceable parts inside.






## Removing the end cap

Use a flathead screwdriver to remove the end cap (C).




## **2** Preparing the lights for the first time

 Separate the mounting cap (B) that is attached to the LED puck assembly (A) by rotating the mounting cap (B) counterclockwise. Repeat this step for the remaining LED puck assemblies (A).



## 3 Installing the mounting caps


 Install the mounting cap (B) to the underside of the cabinet by inserting two mounting screws (AA) into the mounting holes on the mounting cap (B).



### Installation (continued)

## 4 Installing the first LED assembly

 Once the mounting cap (B) is secure, bring the puck light (A) to the mounting cap (B), engage the three catches on the puck (A) into the three groves molded into the cap (B) and turn clockwise.




# 5 Installing the remaining two LED assemblies

 Repeat steps 1 through 4 to install the remaining two LED puck assemblies (A).



NOTE: 1) Ensure the LED puck assemblies install in the same direction so that you can easily connect the LED puck assemblies (A) with each other. 2) Measure the distance of every LED puck assembly (A) before installation.




# **6** Preparing to install the LED driver

- Use the enclosed mounting template (CC) to mark the appropriate screw hole locations.
- Install the mounting screws (AA) in the marked locations.



IMPORTANT: Since mounting is via keyholes, the screw heads should protrude approximately 1/8 in. (3.2 mm) beyond the surface.

## 7 Installing the LED driver





Figure 1 Figure 2

 Secure the LED driver (D) to the mounting surface via keyholes. See Figure 1 and Figure 2.


# 8 Connecting the LED puck lights

 Connect the LED puck assemblies with each other. Connect the LED driver (D) to the fixtures.




# **9** Securing the cords

- Use nail-on fasteners (BB) to attach the wire on the cabinet.
- $\hfill \square$  Re-attach the end cap (C) on the last LED puck assembly (A).




### **Installing Extension Cords (optional)**

As an option to allow for more flexible puck mounting positions, you can add additional extension cords (F) to the fixture as shown:



### Installing the Quick Connector Plug (optional)

- The fixture wire (1) can be cut to the desired length if necessary. This helps to minimize the amount of wire underneath the cabinets.
- Remove the plug cover (2) from the plug (3).
- Press the fixture wire (1), with grooved side (4) to the right (neutral side) down and into the front of the plug (3).
- Press the fixture wire (1) down onto the metal prongs.
- Slide the plug cover (2) back onto the plug over the fixture wire (1).




### **Operation**

## 1 Operating the remote

- □ Pull out the plastic battery barrier sheet from the battery compartment located on the bottom of the remote (E).
- Aim the remote directly at the eye attached to the LED driver (D), and press the ON button and additional control buttons on the remote (E).



**NOTE:** The maximum operating distance with the new batteries, between the remote and the eye on the LED driver is approximately 7 m (22 ft.) with a direct line of sight between two.



## **2** Button descriptions

Review this diagram for detailed information on the functionality of the remote.

٦	Brighten	В	Blue
٩	Dim	W	White
0FF	OFF	FLASH	Flashes between all colors
ON	ON	STROBE	Quickly flashes between all colors
R	Red	FADE	All colors circularly change (Manual)
G	Green	SMOOTH	Smoothly fades across all colors.

To operate the Brighten and Dim controls, hold the button down until you reach the desired  $\,$  light output.




### **Operation (continued)**

## **3** Changing the battery

- Gently remove the battery clip on the bottom of the remote.
- Remove the old battery from the clip and replace with a new battery.
- □ Gently snap the battery clip back in place.







### **Care and Cleaning**

- Before attempting to clean the puck light, unplug the power plug from the outlet.
- □ To clean the puck light use a clean, dry or slightly damp cloth.
- □ Do not use any cleaners with chemicals, solvents or harsh abrasives, as damage to the puck lights may occur.
- Allow the puck light and components to dry thoroughly before plugging the power plug back into the outlet.

## **Troubleshooting**

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution			
The puck light does not turn on.	The LED driver does not have power.	Insert the plug into a live 120V receptacle.			
	The power supply wire is not securely connected to the puck light.	Check the connection and make sure the power supply wire is securely connected to the puck light.			
	Batteries in the remote are dead, not installed correctly, or the plastic barrier sheet has not been removed.	Check to make sure the plastic battery barrier sheet has been removed. Check to make sure the polarity of the batteries is correct. Check to make sure the batteries are not dead.			
	The remote does not have a direct line of sight to the eye on the control box or is too far away.	Check the line of sight and move the eye on the control box accordingly. Make sure that the distance between the remote control and the eye on the control box is within 7 m (22 ft.).
