

Connecting the seat assembly A to the left arm A

- □ Place the left arm A (B) onto a non-abrasive surface, such as a carpet, with its underside facing upwards.
- □ Fasten the seat assembly A (A) to the left arm A (B) by using M6x50 bolts (DD), d6.5xD13x1.0 washers (EE), and M6xP1.0 plastic nuts (FF).






2 Connecting the support A to the seat assembly A and left arm A

- □ Fasten the support A (I) to the seat assembly A (A) by using a M6x16 bolt (AA).
- □ Fasten the support A (I) to the left arm A (B) by using a M6x30 bolt (BB), d6.5xD13x1.0 washer (EE), and M6xP1.0 plastic nut (FF).






3 Connecting the back assembly A to the left arm A

- □ Insert the back assembly A (C) into the left arm A (B).
- □ Fasten the back assembly A (C) to the left arm A (B) by using M6x50 bolts (DD), d6.5xD13x1.0 washers (EE), and M6xP1.0 plastic nuts (FF).






4 Connecting the seat assembly B to the right arm B

- □ Place the right arm B (E) onto a non-abrasive surface, such as a carpet, with its underside facing upwards.
- □ Fasten the seat assembly B (D) to the right arm B (E) by using M6x50 bolts (DD), d6.5xD13x1.0 washers (EE), and M6xP1.0 plastic nuts (FF).






5 Connecting the support B to the seat assembly B


□ Fasten the support B (J) to the seat assembly B (D) by using M6x30 & M6x35 bolts (BB and CC), d6.5xD13x1.0 washers (EE), and M6xP1.0 plastic nuts (FF).





6 Connecting the back assembly B to the support B, seat assembly B, and right arm B


- □ Insert the back assembly B (F) into the right arm B (E).
- □ Fasten the back assembly B (F) to the support B (J) by using M6x30 bolts (BB), d6.5xD13x1.0 washers (EE), and M6xP1.0 plastic nuts (FF).
- □ Fasten the back assembly B (F) to the seat assembly B (D) and the right arm B (E) by using M6x50 bolts (DD), d6.5xD13x1.0 washers (EE), and M6xP1.0 plastic nuts (FF).



7 Connecting the support C to the seat assembly B and seat assembly A

□ Fasten the support C (K) to the seat assembly B (D) and the seat assembly A (A) by using M6x50 bolts (DD), d6.5xD13x1.0 washers (EE), and M6xP1.0 plastic nuts (FF).






8 Connecting the supports to the seat assembly A & B and back assembly A & B

- □ Fasten supports (I and K) to the seat assembly A (A), the seat assembly B (D), the back assembly A (C), and the back assembly B (F) by using M6x35 & M6x50 bolts (CC and DD), d6.5xD13x1.0 washers (EE), and M6xP1.0 plastic nuts (FF).
- □ Fasten the support A (I) to the seat assembly A (A) by using a M6x16 bolt (AA).






9 Connecting the leg A to the legs B


□ Fasten the leg A (G) to legs B (H) by using M6x30 bolts (BB) and d6.5xD13x1.0 washers (EE).





10 Tightening the bolts

- Tighten all bolts that were previously loosely tightened.
- □ Turn the sectional to its upright position. Position all of the sections together as illustrated, to complete your set.
- □ Place cushions (L, M, N, O, and P) onto the frame.



Care and Cleaning

- □ For best results, clean the set with a damp cloth and dry thoroughly. This will help prevent mildew by removing dirt particles that may accumulate.
- □ Do not clean with abrasive materials, bleach, or solvents.
- □ Store the set in a dry, sheltered place when not in use.
- Keep the set away from fire, extreme heat, freezing conditions, and inclement weather such as rain, hail, sleet, snow, or wind.
