WARNING: This chaise was made for the explicit purpose of providing outdoor functions and is not to be used as a toy.

This product is intended for normal outdoor use; however, the manufacturer recommends storing and / or covering this chaise when any formidable / severe weather is approaching.



WARNING: Do not locate this product near open flames. Do not use this product as a support. Do not shake, lean or climb on the product. Children under the age of 10, near the product, should be supervised by a competent adult at all times. This product is NOT intended for commercial use and will void the warranty.

READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USE

To reduce the risk of injury to persons:

- 1. Close supervision is necessary when this product is used by or near children, or disabled persons, if applicable.
- Use this furnishing only for its intended use as described in these instructions. Do not use attachments not recommended by the manufacturer.
- 3. Do not move the chaise while the chaise is occupied. Failure to obey this caution could result in injury.
- 4. Do not rock in the chaise as you may fall and cause serious injury.
- 5. Please keep children out of the assembly area before assembly.





Assembly

1 CONNECTING THE CHAISE SEAT TO THE CHAISE BACK


- Connect the chaise seat (C) to the chaise back (D) using M6x25 combination bolts (BB) and plastic washers (DD).
- Do not fully tighten the bolts at this step.



Assembly (continued)

2 connecting the chaise seat and the connection bar to the left arm


- Place the left arm (B) on a soft surface, and attach the chaise seat (C) to the left arm (B) using M6x45 combination bolts (CC) and plastic washers (DD), as shown below.
- Attach the connection bar (E) to the left arm (B) using an M6x20 combination bolt (AA) and M6x45 combination bolt (CC).
- Do not fully tighten all the bolts at this step.



Assembly (continued)

3 CONNECTING THE CHAISE SEAT AND THE CONNECTION BAR TO THE RIGHT ARM


- Place the right arm (A) on a soft surface.
- □ Attach the chaise seat (C) to the right arm (A) using M6x45 combination bolts (CC) and plastic washers (DD), as shown below.
- Attach the connection bar (E) to the right arm (A) using an M6x20 combination bolt (AA) and M6x45 combination bolt (CC).
- Do not fully tighten all the bolts at this step.



Assembly (continued)

4 TIGHTENING THE BOLTS

- Once all of the bolts are in place, fully tighten the bolts.
- □ Turn the chaise right side up.
- □ Ensure all connections are secure before use.
- Place the cushion (F) to finish the assembly of the chaise.



Care and Cleaning

- For best results, clean the chaise with a damp cloth and dry thoroughly. This will help prevent mildew by removing dirt particles that may accumulate.
- □ Do not clean with abrasive materials, bleach, or solvents.
- Store the chaise in a dry, sheltered place when not in use.
- □ Keep the chaise away from fire, extreme heat, freezing conditions, and inclement weather such as rain, hail, sleet, snow, or wind.
