
Planting & Caring Service Shrub





Cut the box open from the bottom and remove the plant.



Remove the plastic bag and give your plant a drink. It's been a long trip.


Read the back of the plant tag for spacing and sun needs.



Dig a hole twice as wide as the hole is deep.



Mix soil and fertilizer and then backfille the hole with the mixed soil





Remove the plant from it's container. Place in the hole, level with the surface



Water Until the Soil underneath the mulch is moist.

Make sure to keep your tree or shrub consistently moist. Dry soil and soaking wet soil are huge killers of plants



Cover the base with a mulch such as pine straw, pine or cypress bark, or other wood chips to prevent weeds.
