



Assembly Instructions

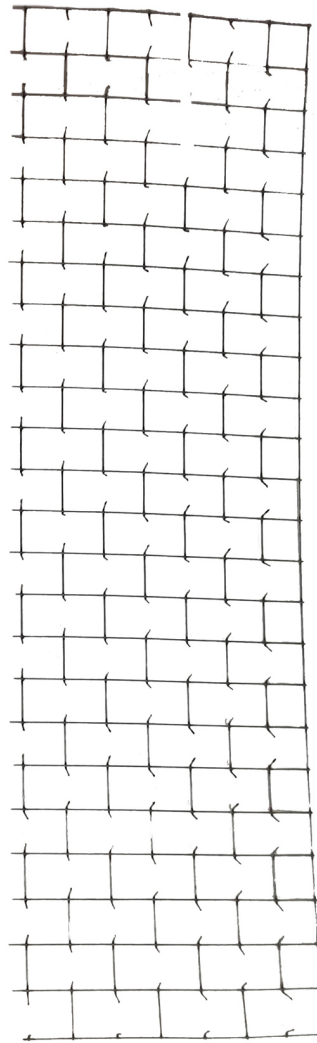
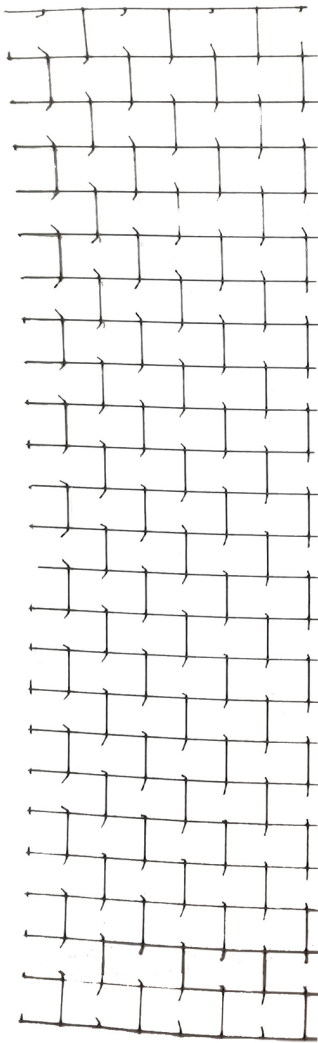
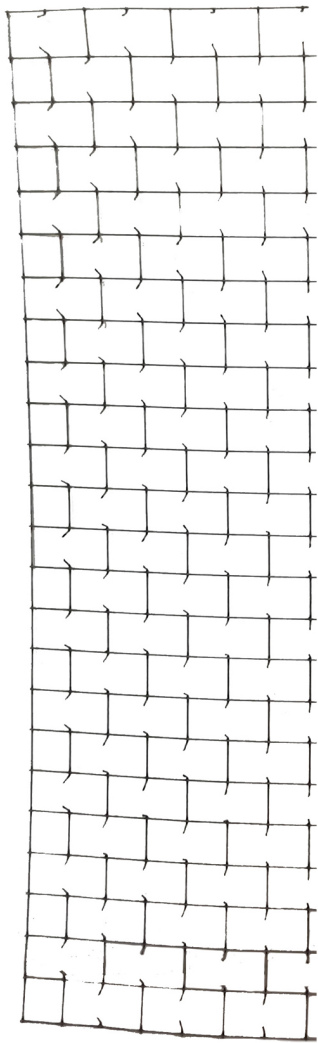
Package Content: You should have 4 items (see page 2 for details) per set.

- 4 Arbor Shield divided into 3 strips per shield, total 12 strips
 - 3 rebar support rods
 - 11 tie wire – 5 for shield, 2 per rod.
1. *Form a triangle with 3 AS strips – see page 3 for reference.
 - Attach strips together with tie wire!
 2. Ground support rods at each corner of the formed triangle.
 - Place the AS triangle around the tree to help gauge best location for grounding rods.
 - Use a hammer or our rod-grounding tool when grounding many.
 - Each rod measures 5 feet. Make sure to ground at least 1/3 and up to 1/2 of the length of the rods into the ground depending on the soil consistency in your area.
 3. Use tie wire to tie the rods to the AS (Can be done manually or with pliers or our tie wire to help when tying many).
 - Use 2 wires per rod and tie at equal distances to help fixate.
 4. Sit back and watch animals get deterred from destroying your tree!

**NOTE – YOU can attach several shields together for a larger diameter protection or stack on top of each other for higher protection. Explained above is the standard single shield protection.*
