

# Connecting to a Wi-Fi Network

On the app Home screen select (...)

Select the Settings icon Select "Advanced"




The app will automatically select the nearest Wi-Fi network, select the drop down menu to select a different network.



## Reset to Factory Settings

If you forgot your camera password or you are experiencing difficulties operating/setting up your camera, please reset to factory settings, and setup the camera again.




- Connect the included Antenna to the back of the Bayit Cam. - Plug one end of the enclosed power adapter into the Power jack of the Bayit Cam, and the other end of the Power adapter into the wall outlet.
- Press the WPS button on your Wi-Fi router, If your router does not have a physical WPS button, you may need to activate WPS through its web interface. Refer to your router's manual for more details.
- Within 30 seconds press the WPS button on the Bayit Cam



- If the connection was successful, Bayit Cam will already be connected to your Wi-Fi network, proceed to step 4 "Setting up Bayit Cam" to complete the setup. - If the connection was not successful please proceed with a wired setup in step 3 "Connecting the Hardware".

## Connecting the Hardware

Plug one end of the enclosed Ethernet cable into the Ethernet port on the Bayit Cam, and the other end of the cable into an Ethernet port on the Wi-Fi router (not included). The Ethernet cable can be removed after the initial setup is complete.
