Care Tip: As flowers fade, deadhead to promote continued flowering. They like moist conditions.

Exposure: Full sun to partial shade *Height:* Grows 28-32" tall *Spacing:* Plant 12" apart, 2-4" deep *Hardy in:* USDA zones 3-9
