Parts List



First Time Battery Installation:

Locate battery compartment for this product .

Use alkaline batteries for maximum performance .

Using a small Phillips head screwdriver – loosen and remove the battery compartment cover screw(s).

Remove battery compartment cover .

Install new batteries only after reading the "Battery Information NOTICE"!

Replace compartment cover and secure cover with the cover screw . Do not over tighten and strip out the screw .

IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

Please retain this information for future reference. Batteries must be installed / replaced by an adult .

Notice:

- 1. Remove and replace batteries when the electrical features of this product work slowly or are not functional .
- 2. Do not mix old and new batteries .
- 3. Do not mix di erent types of batteries : Alkaline , Standard (Carbon-Zinc) , or rechargeable (Nickel-Cadmium batteries) .
- 4. Use Alkaline Batteries for maximum performance .
- 5. Do not use damaged batteries .
- 6. Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
- 7. Install new batteries as per matching the battery polarity guide (+ & -, positive and negative) inside of the battery compartment. Correct battery polarity installation is critical as to not damage the internal electrical components as well as insuring the correct functionality of the product.
- 8. Do not short circuit the battery terminals .
- 9. Always remove exhausted , leaking, weak , and batteries from long periods of nonuse from the product . Battery leakage and corrosion can cause damage .
- 10. Check the battery terminals are clean and bright before installing new batteries.
- 11. Dispose of old batteries safely and per local battery disposal codes .
- 12. Do not dispose of batteries into a fire as they may explode or leak.
- 13. If removable rechargeable batteries are used , they are to be charged under adult supervision .

Assembly Instructions

FIG.1 Place the Bean Bag Board face down on the ground.





FIG.2 Insert a 9V battery into the battery compartment to power on the LEDs when playing at night (battery not included). See "Battery Installation procedure" on page 3 before installing the batteries.



DO NOT INSTALL BATTERY BACKWARDS, CHARGE, OR DISPOSE OF IN FIRE. BATTERY MAY EXPLODE OR LEAK.



Glow Stick Instructions

HANDLE WITH CARE: Handle the glow sticks carefully to avoid accidental activation. Keep glow sticks in the package and store in a cool, dry place until ready to use. Remove gently from the bean bag before use.

CAUTION: Do not puncture or cut glow sticks. Ingredients are non-toxic and nonflammable, but may permanently stain fabrics or furniture. Contact with skin or eyes may cause temporary discomfort. In case of skin or eye contact, rinse thoroughly with water. Do not drink or ingest glow sticks or their contents. Do not bend glow sticks after activation. Do not leave glow sticks in direct sunlight or expose to high temperatures. Contains small parts; not suitable for children under 3 years of age. Dispose of glow sticks properly after use.

To activate a glow stick, bend along the entire length of the stick and shake. It may take a few minutes to glow completely.

IMPORTANT: Bend along the entire length of the glow stick and shake before reinserting it into the bean bag for glow e ect. Glows 6-8 hours.





Step 1: Remove mini glow stick from the side of the bean bag.


Step 2: Bend the glow stick


Step 3: Shake the glow stick

Step 4: Slide the mini glow stick back into the side of the bean bag for night play.

NOTE: The light stick "glow" expectancy is approximately 6 hours. Light sticks can be discarded after glow life.

FIG.4 Turn the board right-side-up, and YOU ARE NOW READY TO PLAY.





The LED light flashes when the bean bag hits through the target hole.

NOTE: Battery compartment underneath board has an on/o switch. Please switch o when not when not in use to preserve the battery.

Game Rules



Bag Toss 2 to 8 players

Preparation: Set boards 15 feet apart.

Game Rules:

Each team has 4 Bean Bags. Players should alternate throws during their team's turn.

Hint: You can knock your opponent's Bean Bags o the board.

A bag thrown through the hole earns 3 points. A bag that lands on the board earns 1 point. Subtract the low score from the high score for each round of play. For example: Team A has 1 bag in the hole and 2 bags on the board, for a score of 5 points. Team B has two bags on the board, for a score of 2 points. Team A (5 points) – Team B (2 points) = Team A (3 points). Team A receives 3 points for that round of play.

Game is played until one team scores 21 points. A team can win by a white wash which is 11 - 0. A white wash can not occur in the first half of the first round. (All 4 bags in the hole by player 1 of team 1 and only 1 point or zero points by player 1 of team 2.)

A bag that is tossed in play and knocks another bag o or in the hole is legal.

A bag that bounces from the ground onto the board is not a legal play. This bag must be removed from the board and play is then continued.
