

CARE AND MAINTENANCE VERANDA VINYL FENCING

Vinyl is virtually maintenance-free. You'll never need to paint, scrape, or stain a vinyl fence. As with most exterior products, a Veranda vinyl fence may get dirty when exposed to the elements. To keep your fence looking new, pressure-wash it occasionally with a mild detergent and water. To remove stubborn stains, use a soft-bristled brush and a non-abrasive cleanser.

Does vinyl fencing resist mildew and mold?

The surface of vinyl fencing is smooth and non-porous, making it difficult for mildew to grow there. Mildew forms only under the wettest conditions and is easily removed with mild detergent and water.

Is vinyl graffiti-proof?

While not classified as graffiti-proof, vinyl's non-porous surface makes it difficult for graffiti to adhere to it. Most paint can be easily removed with water and mild detergent. A pressure washer or paint thinner can be used for stubborn stains.

Will vinyl turn yellow over time?

No. Veranda vinyl contains TiO2, which prevents discoloration caused by exposure to the sun and the environment. All of our vinyl fencing products are guaranteed to resist discoloration for 20 years.
