



## CARE AND MAINTENANCE VERANDA VINYL FENCING

Vinyl is virtually maintenance-free. You'll never need to paint, scrape, or stain a vinyl fence. As with most exterior products, a Veranda vinyl fence may get dirty when exposed to the elements. To keep your fence looking new, pressure-wash it occasionally with a mild detergent and water. To remove stubborn stains, use a soft-bristled brush and a non-abrasive cleanser.

### **Does vinyl fencing resist mildew and mold?**

The surface of vinyl fencing is smooth and non-porous, making it difficult for mildew to grow there. Mildew forms only under the wettest conditions and is easily removed with mild detergent and water.

### **Is vinyl graffiti-proof?**

While not classified as graffiti-proof, vinyl's non-porous surface makes it difficult for graffiti to adhere to it. Most paint can be easily removed with water and mild detergent. A pressure washer or paint thinner can be used for stubborn stains.

### **Will vinyl turn yellow over time?**

No. Veranda vinyl contains TiO<sub>2</sub>, which prevents discoloration caused by exposure to the sun and the environment. All of our vinyl fencing products are guaranteed to resist discoloration for 20 years.
