THE GENERAL CARE AND CLEANING OF ANY PORCELAIN VESSEL SINK

For general maintenance, all porcelain sinks can be regularly cleaned with a mild detergent, warm water, and a soft cloth. Wipe and dry your porcelain sink after each use to protect against hard water stains, which may become difficult to eliminate. For a thorough cleaning after extended use, or to remove stubborn stains, follow the instructions on the reverse side.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

SHINE

Life can be brought back to a porcelain sink finish by pouring vinegar straight into the sink bowl. Using a nylon brush, scrub the surface with the vinegar, rinse thoroughly, and enjoy the revitalized finish.

SANITIZATION

For a thorough cleaning of a porcelain sink, a mild chlorine-bleach cleaner such as Soft Scrub® can be used. Rinse immediately after use, and dry. Be sure to follow the manufacturer's instructions for any store-bought cleaning product.

Another option is to let the sink soak in a bleach solution (approximately 1 part bleach to 3 parts water) for 30 minutes to an hour. Then drain, rinse well, and dry. We recommend Clorox® bleach.

SCUFFING

For superficial scuff marks (gray lines in the surface), use a sponge or soft cloth to gently apply a paste of baking soda and water. Rinse thoroughly and dry. A polishing cleanser will

also remove stains without scratching. Be sure to follow manufacturer's instructions for any store-bought polishing product.

DAMAGES

Porcelain is very durable, but dropping heavy objects on it can chip the surface. Even the smallest chip will leave the area rough and susceptible to stains and germs. In the event of a chip or minor damage, be sure to keep the location clean and dry. Consult your local plumber for repairs.
