*The maximum number of cameras you can connect to your Wireless Gateway will be determined by the number of channels.*

- 1 Sync Button** – Press for approximately 3 seconds to search for and sync to Devices that are in Pairing Mode (ex. IP Cameras or Doorbell). This process may take up to a minute.
- 2 microSD** – The maximum microSD card size is 128 GB. The microSD card can be formatted using the Night Owl App.
- 3 Network: Ethernet Cable (RJ-45 Cable) Port** – Connect the Gateway to a Router using the included Ethernet Cable (RJ-45). The Gateway will search for the Internet when powered on, and on a frequent basis thereafter. The Internet Status Light will be solid green when connected to the Internet.
- 4 Power Input** – Use the included Gateway Power Cord only.
- 5 Reset** – Press for approximately 10 seconds to reset the Gateway to Factory Settings. This process will reboot the Gateway and clear all the Channels of synced devices. This process will unlink the connection of the Gateway from the Night Owl App. The Gateway will have to be deleted from the App, and then re-added.

**NOTE:** Resetting the factory settings removes all devices from the Gateway. After resetting, press the Sync Button for approximately 3 seconds to locate and sync previously paired devices, even if the devices are not in pairing mode.

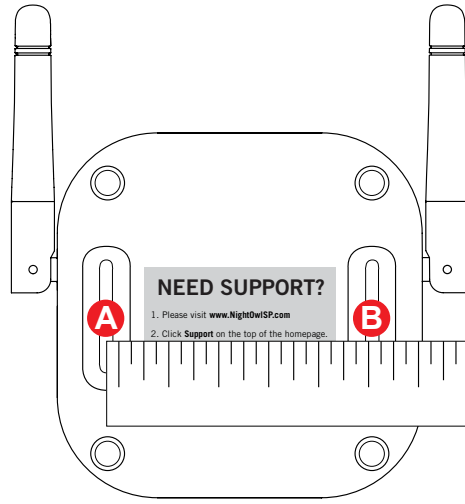

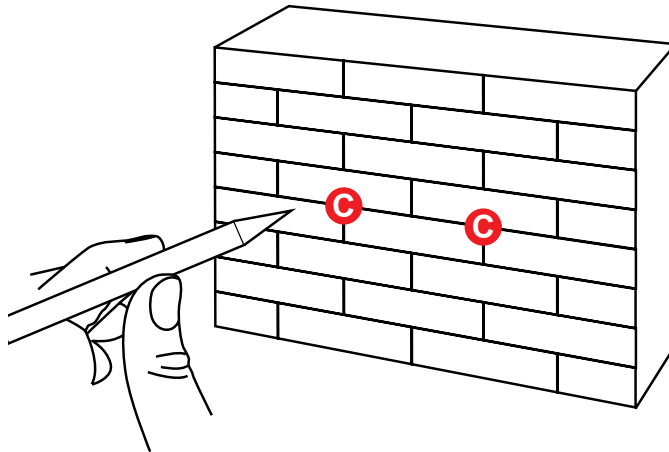
## MOUNTING THE GATEWAY

For the best experience, the Gateway should be centrally located in your home/business and close to your router.

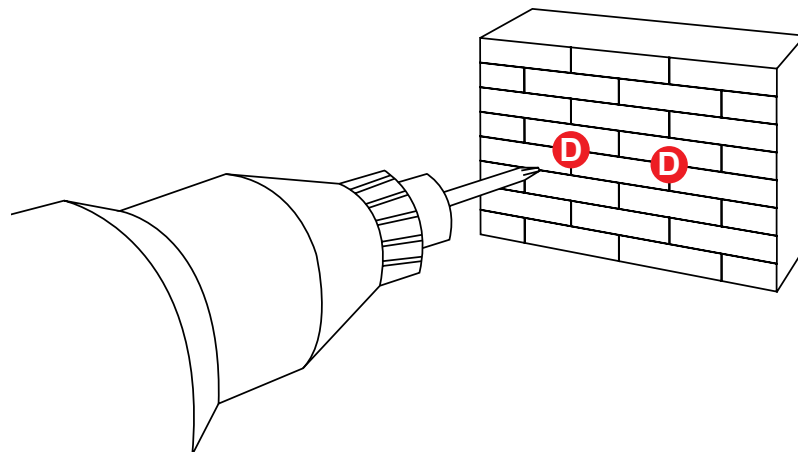
- 1 Measure the distance between **A** and **B**.



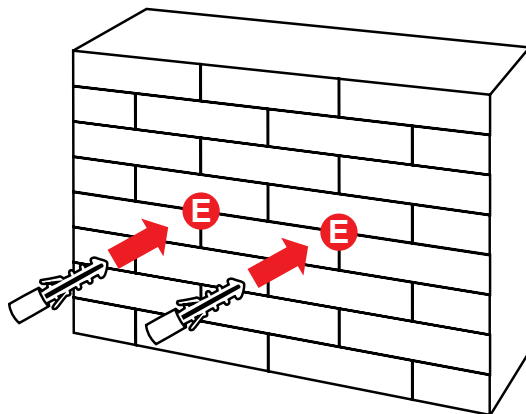
- 2 Make 2-hole marks **C** on the mounting surface using the measurement from step 1.



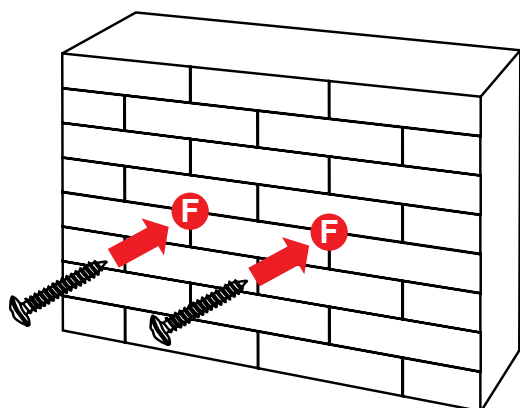
- 3 Use a drill or screwdriver to make holes in the mounting surface **D**.



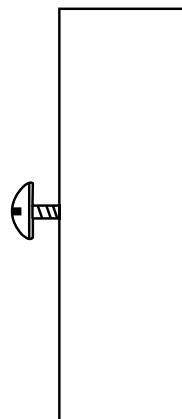
- 4 Insert the included wall anchors into each hole **E**.



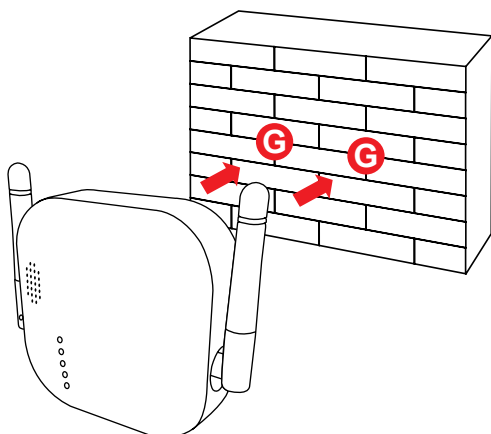
- 5 Insert a screw into each wall anchor **F**. Fasten until it is almost flush with the surface.



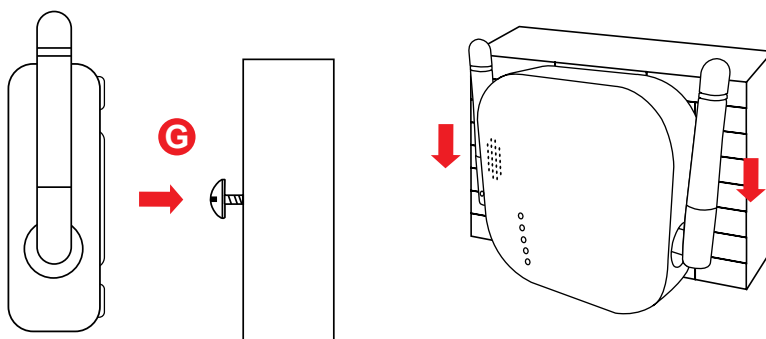




- 6 Fit the Gateway over the screws and slowly slide down until secured **G**.

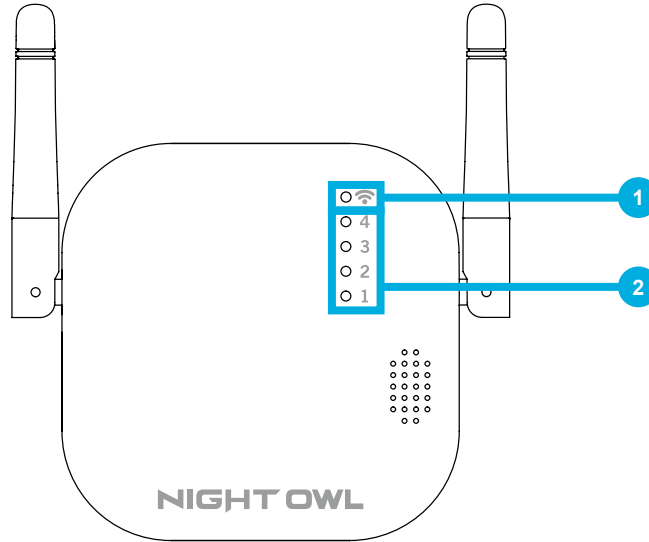

# Chapter 4: Status Light Keys

## Gateway Status Light Key



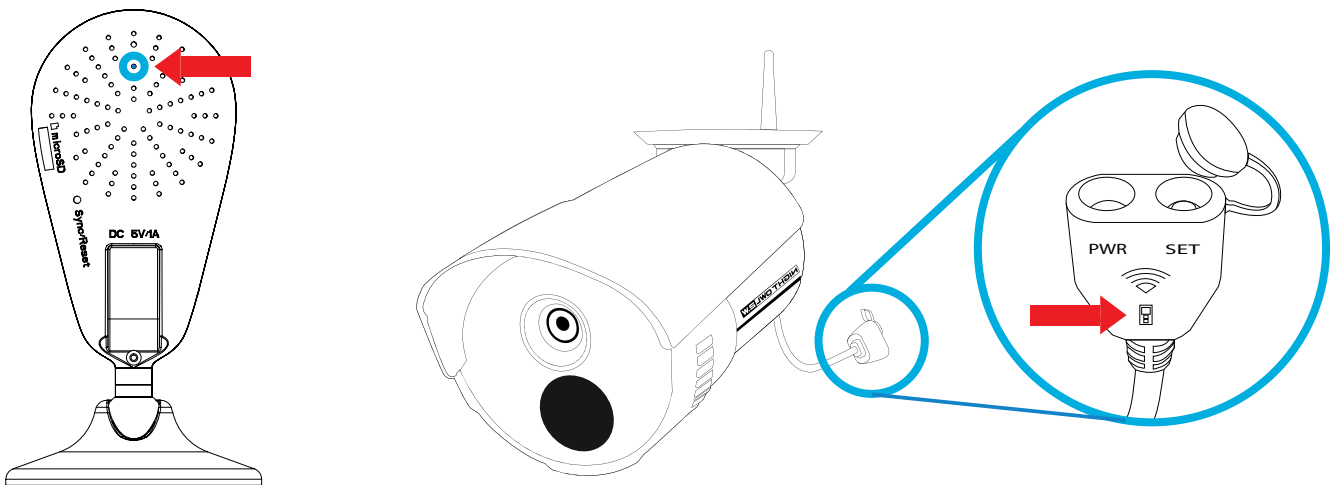
### 1 Internet Status Light:

- **Green Steady:** Connected to the Internet.
- **Green Blinking:** Internet is not available.
- **No Light:** Gateway has no power.

### 2 Channel Status Lights:

- **Green Steady:** A Device is synced to the Gateway.
- **Green Blinking:** Device is associated to the Gateway but there is NO connection between them.  
(i.e. IP CAMERA is OFF or was Factory Reset)
- **No Light:** Channel is not associated with a Device.

## Camera Status Light Key



- **Quickly Flashing:** Camera is in Pairing Mode (Default)
- **Slowly Flashing:** Camera is not connected to the Gateway or Wi-Fi network
- **Solid Light:** Camera is connected to the Gateway or a Wi-Fi network



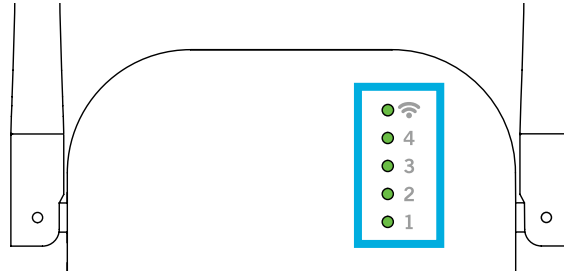

# Chapter 5: Getting Started

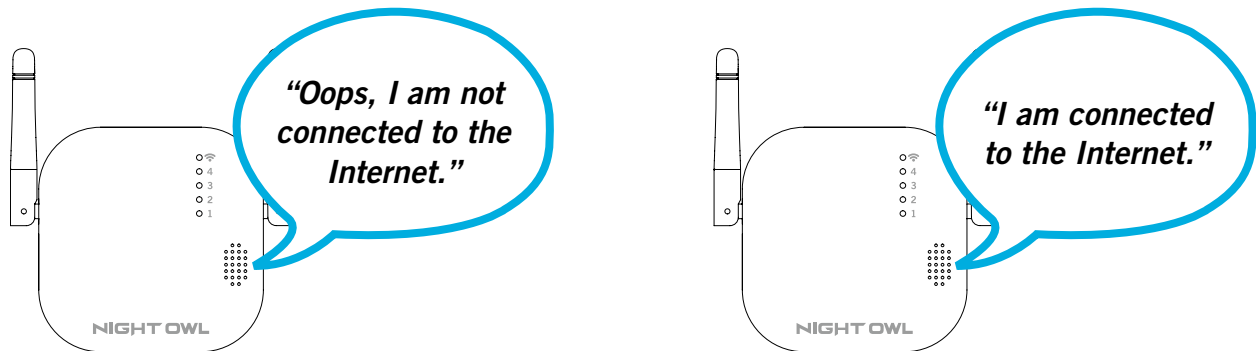
## 5.1 Booting Process

- 1 The status lights will be a steady green for up to 30 seconds.
- 2 The status lights will flash green for 1-2 seconds.



- 3 The Gateway plays the voice prompt: ***“Hello, I am powering up. Be patient and please leave my power on.”***
- 4 The Gateway checks for an Internet connection (may take up to a minute). A voice prompt will either say ***“Oops, I am NOT connected to the Internet”*** or ***“I am connected to the Internet.”***

**NOTE:** The Gateway **MUST** be connected to the internet to search for, and update to, the latest Firmware version.



- 5 When connected to the internet, the Gateway will search for the latest Firmware version.
  - 5a If there is no new Firmware available, the Gateway plays the voice prompt ***“Thanks for checking, but my Firmware is up to date.”***
  - 5b If there is new Firmware available, the Gateway plays the voice prompt ***“I am upgrading my Firmware. Be patient and please leave my power ON.”***

After the upgrade is completed, the Gateway plays the voice prompt ***“WooHoo! Firmware upgrade is complete.”***

If the upgrade fails, the Gateway plays the voice prompt ***“Oops, the upgrading process failed, please retry later.”***

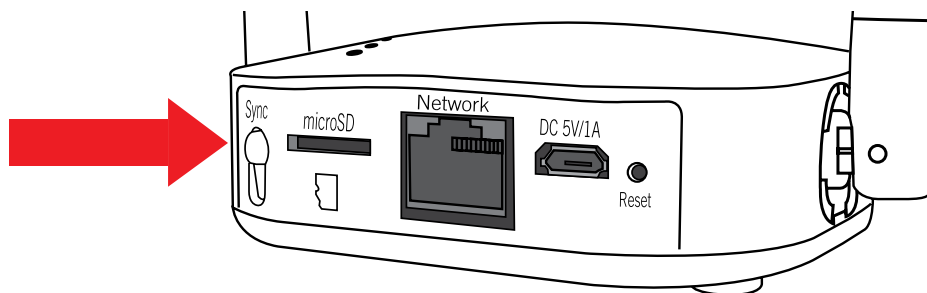
**NOTE:** If the upgrade is successful, the Gateway will automatically reboot and update the Firmware.

- 6 The Gateway searches its channels for connected Night Owl devices.
  - 6a If there are no devices paired with the Gateway, the voice prompt ***“Pair me to other Night Owl devices by pressing my Sync button for 3 seconds”*** will play.
  - 6b If the Gateway is paired with 1 or more Night Owl devices, NO audio will be played.
- 7 Booting process is complete.

## 5.2 Gateway Functionality

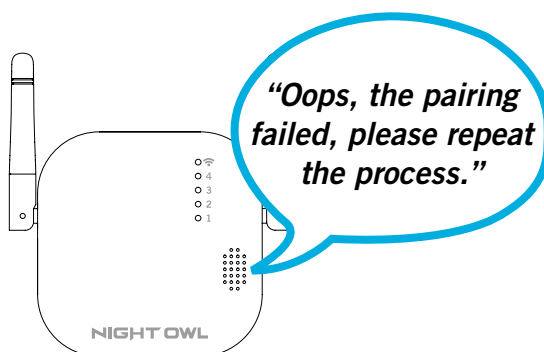
### 5.2.1 Pair Night Owl Devices

- 1 Press the Sync button for approximately 3 seconds to start the pairing process. The Gateway will play the voice prompt ***“I am pairing to the Night Owl Device, please be patient.”***

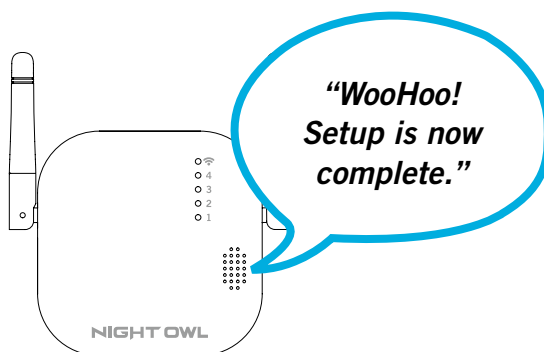


**NOTE:** If all of the channels are in use, the Gateway will play the voice prompt ***“Oops, all my channels are in use. To add more devices, buy another me.”***

- 2 The Gateway will spend up to 1 minute searching for Night Owl Devices to pair.
  - 2a If the Gateway doesn't find any Night Owl Devices to pair with, the voice prompt ***“Oops, the pairing failed, please repeat the process.”*** will play.
  - 2b When adding multiple Night Owl Devices to the Gateway, if at least one fails to pair, you will hear the voice prompt ***“Oops, the pairing failed, please repeat the process.”***

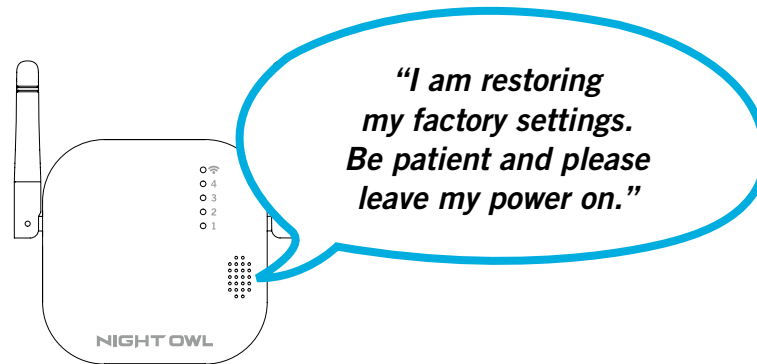


- 2c When the Gateway successfully pairs to ALL Night Owl devices, the voice prompt will say ***“WooHoo! Setup is now complete.”***

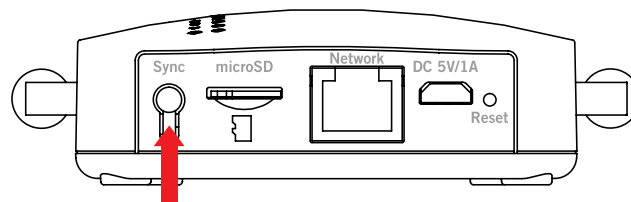


## 5.2.2 Resetting Gateway to Factory Settings

- 1 Press the Reset Button for approximately 10 seconds. The Gateway's voice prompt will say ***"I am restoring my factory settings. Be patient and please leave my power on."***




- 2 Once the Gateway is reset, it will automatically reboot.
- 3 Resetting the factory settings removes all devices from the Gateway. Press the Sync Button for approximately 3 seconds to add previously paired Night Owl Devices, even if those devices are not in pairing mode.



**NOTE:** If a Night Owl Device (i.e., Cameras, Doorbell) is restored to its factory settings, it **MUST** be in pairing mode to be added to the Gateway.

- 4 The Gateway **MUST** be deleted from the Night Owl App and then added again.

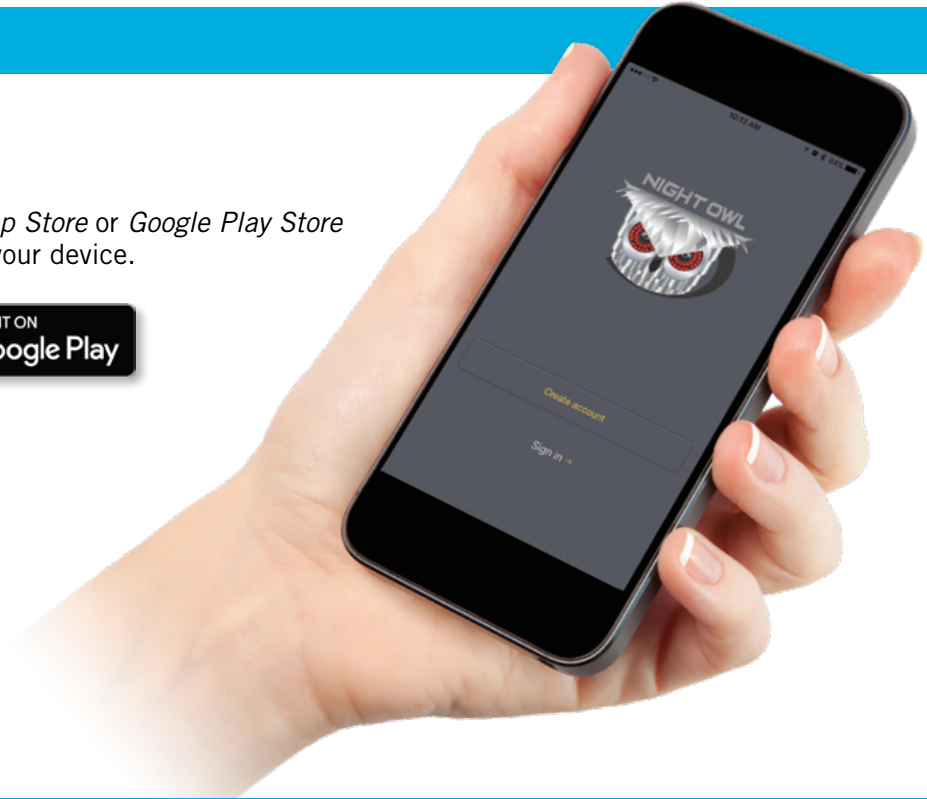

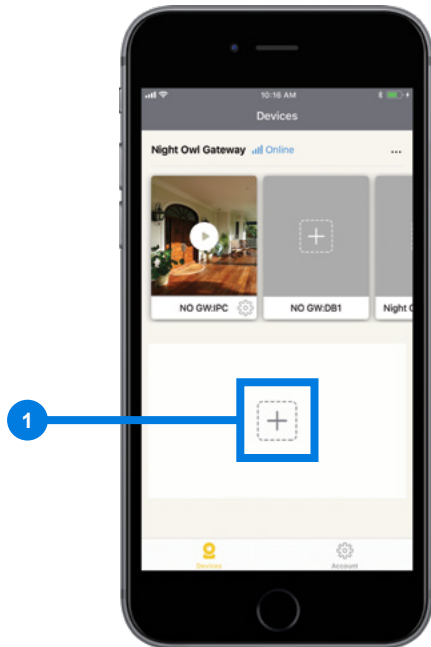
### Download and Install Application

- 1 Download the App from the *App Store* or *Google Play Store* and install the application on your device.

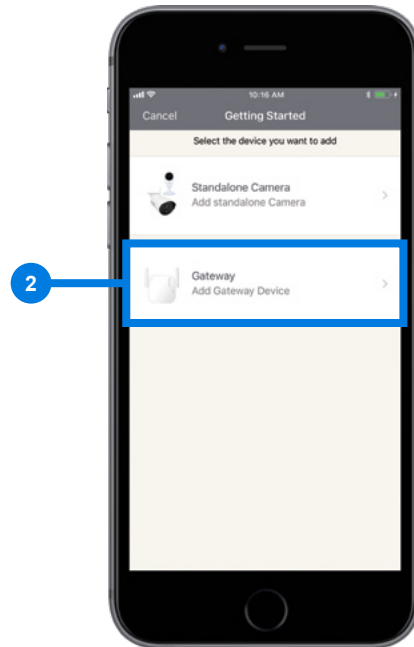

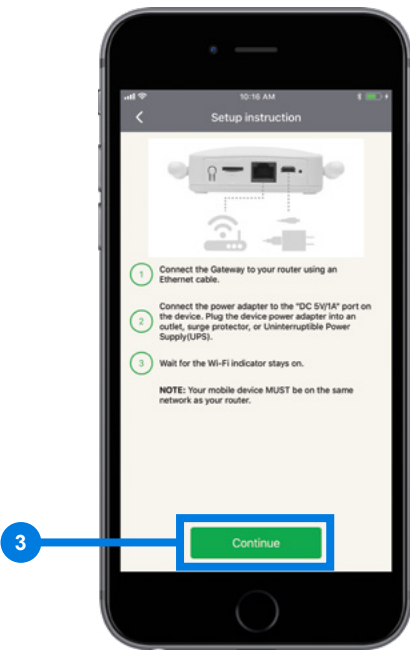
### 6.2.1 Add Gateway



- 1 Press the “+” icon.



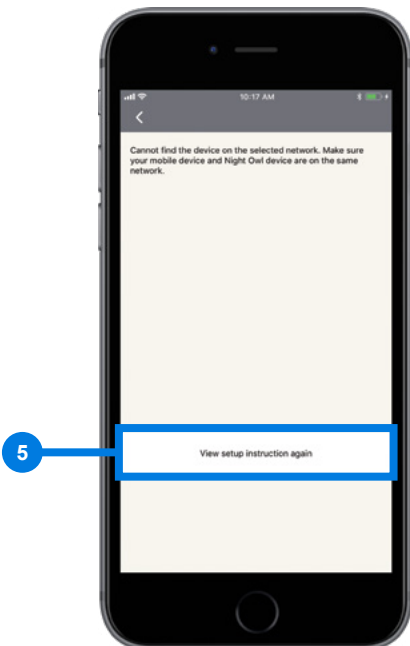
- 2 Select “**Gateway**” from the device list and follow the onscreen instructions.



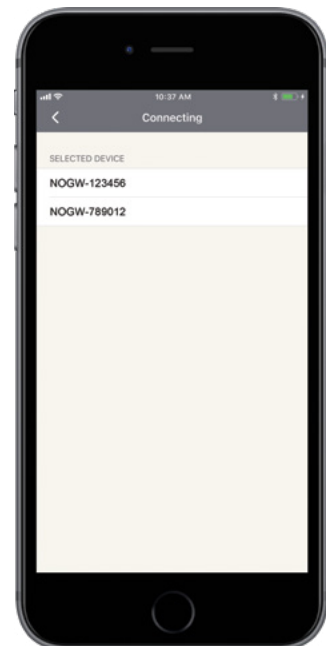
3 Make sure the Smart Device running the Night Owl App is on the same network as the Gateway during setup. Tap **"Continue"** to allow the App to locate the Gateway.



4 Be patient as the App finds the Gateway.

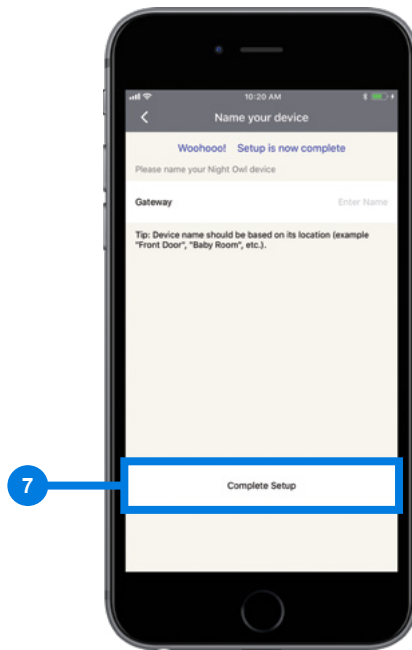


5 If the Night Owl App does not find the Gateway, tap **"View setup instructions again"** and make sure the Smart Device running the App is on the same network as the Gateway.



6 If there are multiple Gateways on the same network as the Smart Device running the Night Owl App, they will be listed here.



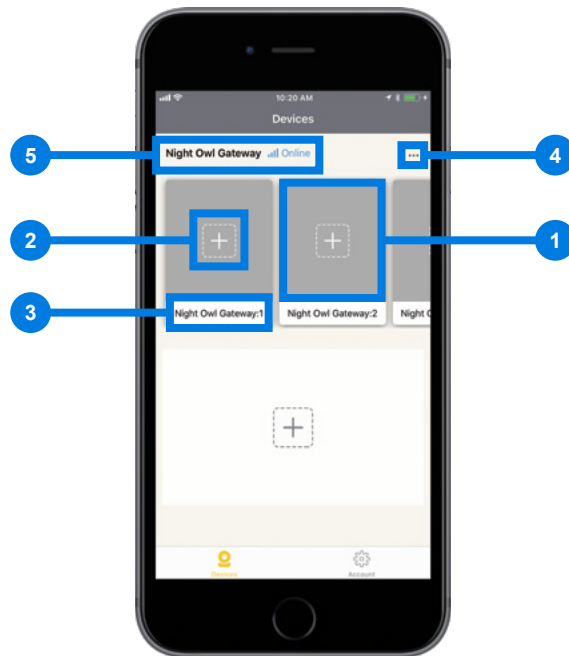


- 7 When the setup is successful, you will be prompted to name the Gateway.

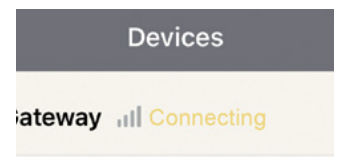
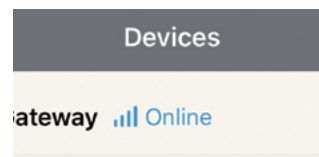
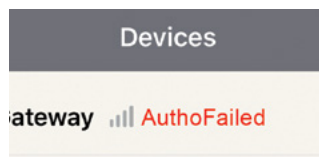
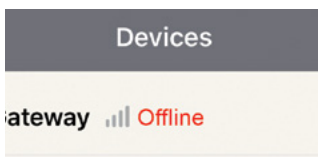


- 8 Example of a newly added Gateway with no cameras.

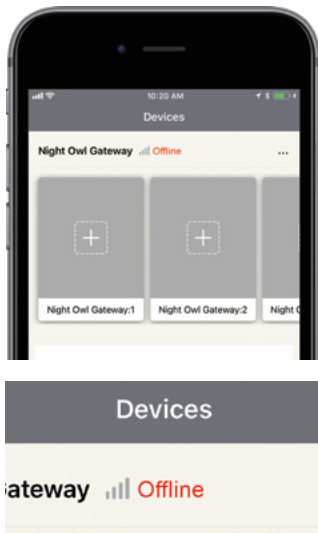
## 6.2.2 Main Screen Explanation



- 1 The Gateway's channels are displayed here. If the “+” icon is visible, the channel isn't paired with a device. The channels bar scrolls left and right.
- 2 Tapping the “+” icon on an individual channel allows the user to add more Night Owl devices to the Gateway. This method adds all the Night Owl Devices that are in pairing mode to the Gateway.
- 3 The channels name.
- 4 Tap the “**Settings**” icon to access the Gateway's Settings Menu. If the Gateway is in “**Offline**” or “**Autho Failed**” status, tap the “**Settings**” icon to reconnect the App to the Gateway. If a connection is NOT made, the Settings Menu will not be accessible.
- 5 The Gateway's name and connection status.

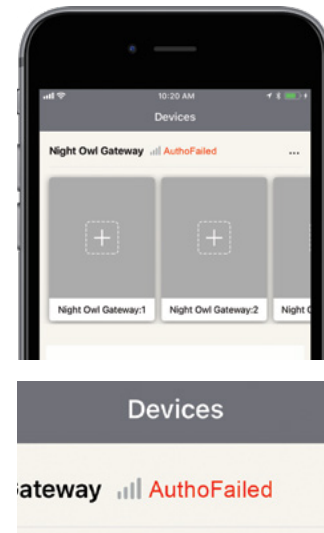


## 6.2.2 (a) Status Explanation

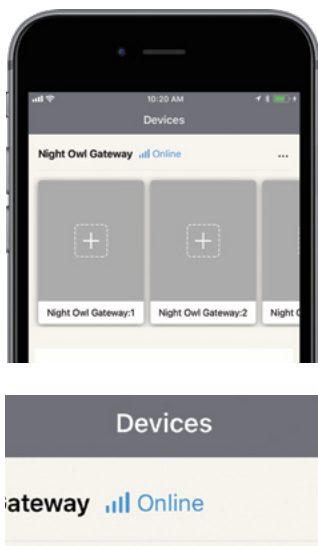


**Offline:** The Night Owl App isn't communicating with the Gateway due to one of the following reasons:

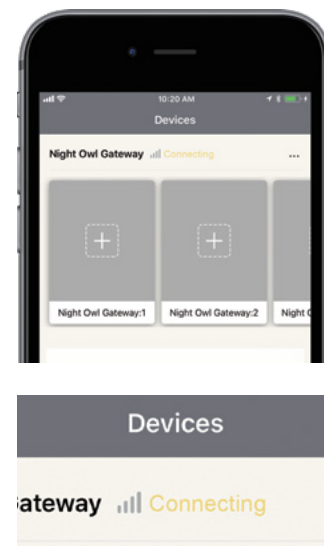
- 1 The Gateway is turned OFF.
- 2 The Gateway isn't connected to the internet.
- 3 The Smart Device running the Night Owl App isn't connected to the internet.



**Authentication Failed:** The Gateway has been reset to Factory Settings but hasn't been deleted from the App. You **MUST** delete the Gateway from the App and then add it back to view the channel stream.

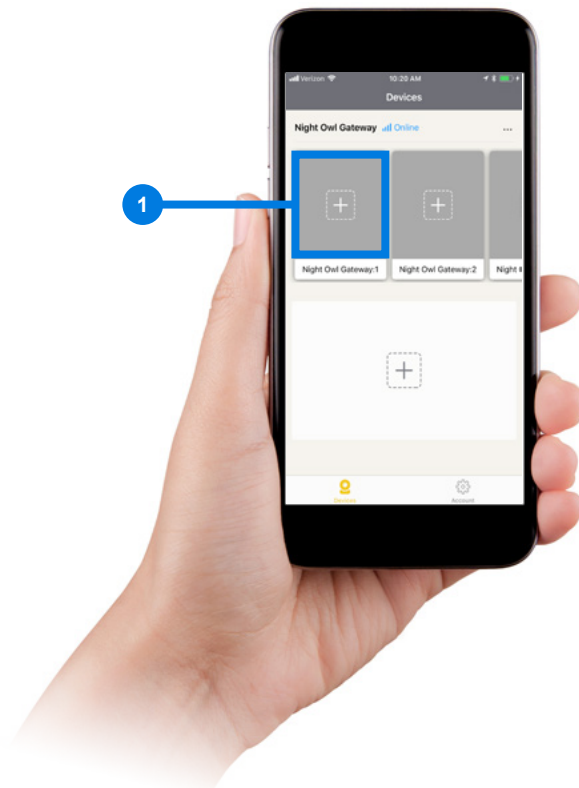


**Online:** The Gateway and the App are communicating. The user can access the live stream and use all the features.

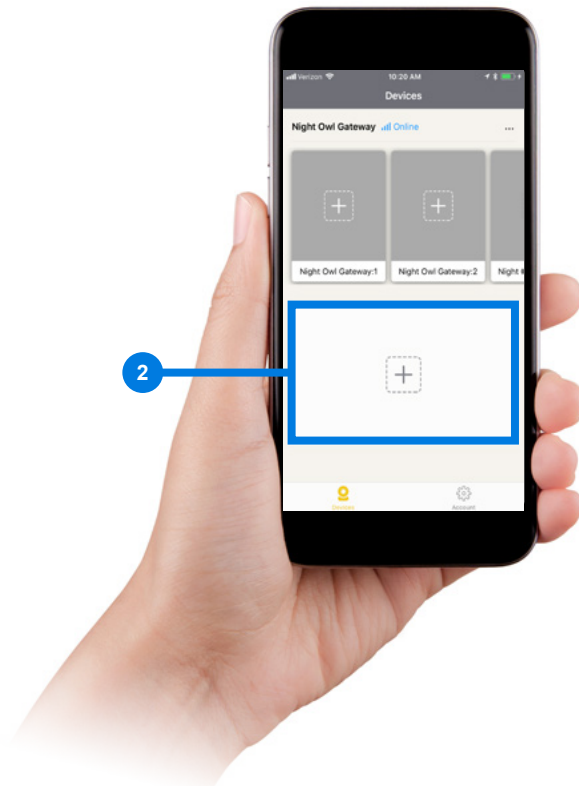


**Connecting:** The App is trying to establish a connection with the Gateway.

## 6.2.3 Add Night Owl Device to Gateway

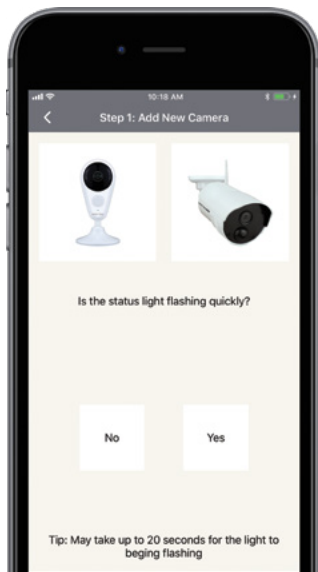


- 1 Tap the channels “+” icon to go directly to the instructions for adding Night Owl devices to the Gateway.

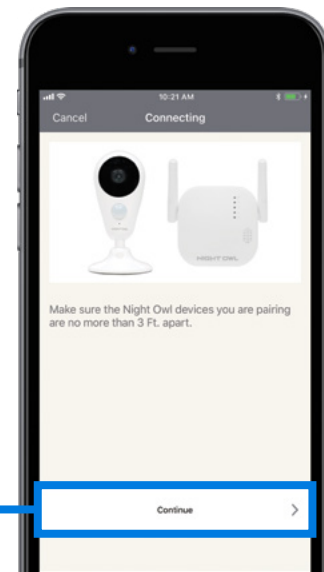


- 2 Select a Night Owl device (except the Gateway) and follow the onscreen instructions to add to the Gateway or a Wi-Fi network.

## 6.2.3 (a) Pressing “ADD” Icon



- 1 Tap “**Yes**” if the Night Owl Device’s status light is flashing quickly (in pairing mode). Tap “**No**” for pairing instructions.



- 2 Follow the onscreen instructions and tap “**Continue.**”

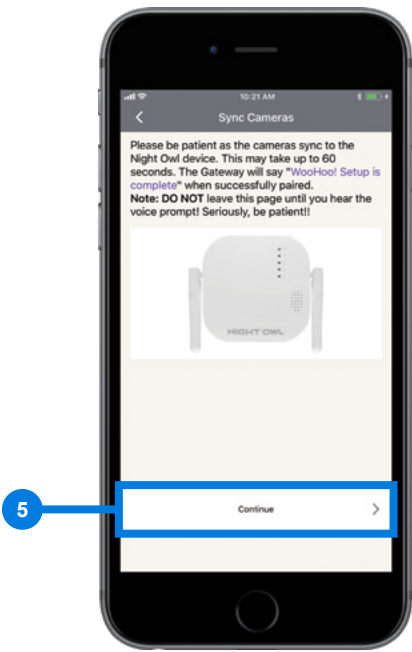


- 3 Follow the onscreen instructions and tap “**Continue.**”

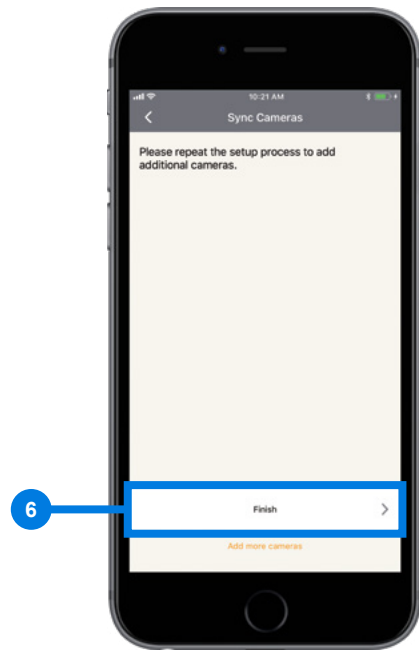


- 4 Follow the onscreen instructions and tap “**Continue.**”

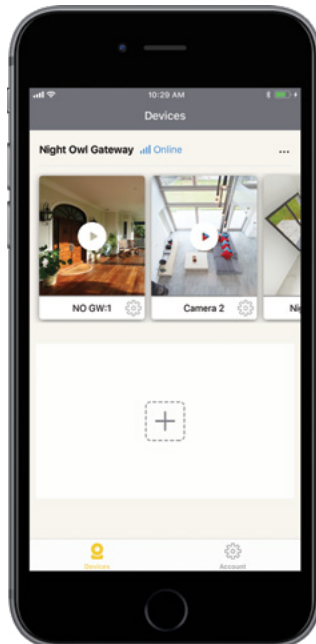
**NOTE:** All Night Owl devices in “Pairing Mode” and in proximity to the Gateway will begin the pairing process. Devices added cannot exceed the number of channels. The Pairing process may take up to a minute.



- 5 Follow the onscreen instructions and tap “Continue.”



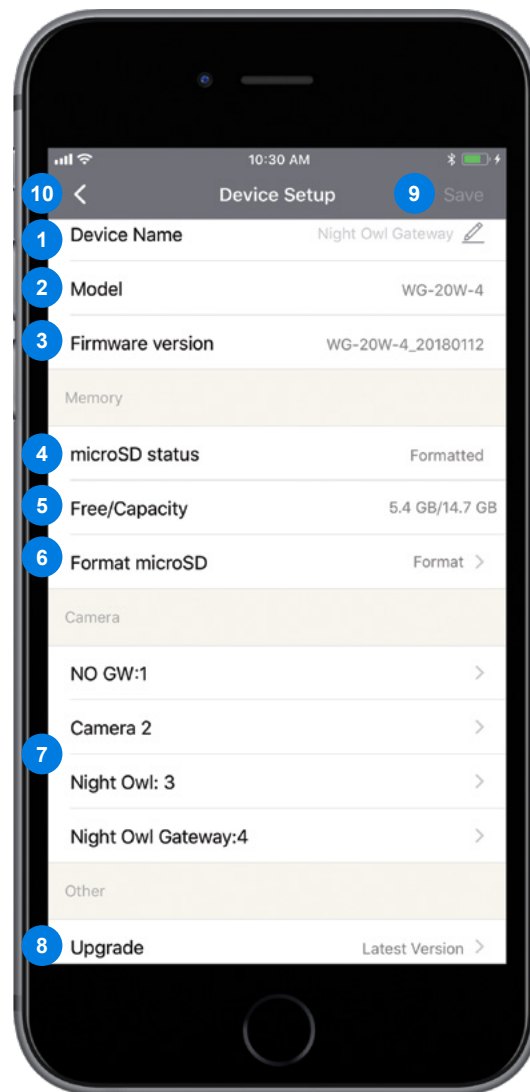
- 6 Tap “Finish” to return to the “Devices” screen. Selecting “Add more cameras” will take you back to step 1 of this section.



- 7 When adding a Night Owl device to the Gateway, the “Devices” screen will look like the picture above. Tap the “Play Button” on an individual channel to view the live stream.

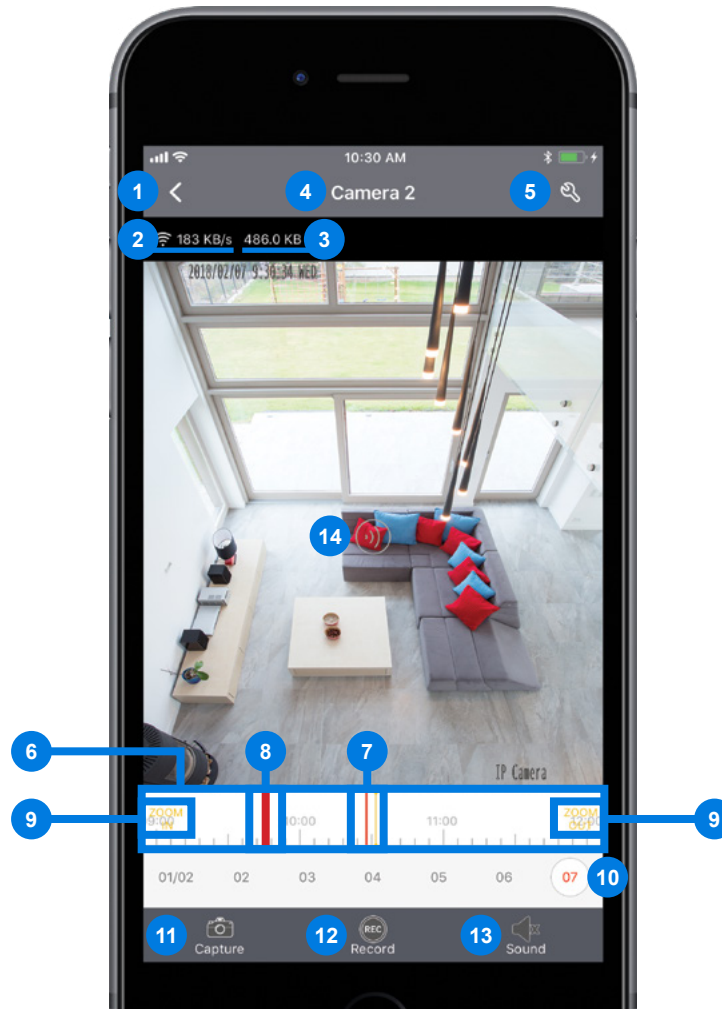
**NOTE:** Each device has its own “Settings” icon next to the name.

## 6.2.4 Night Owl Gateway Settings



- 1 **Device Name:** View and edit the device's name.
- 2 **Model:** The model # of your Gateway.
- 3 **Firmware Version:** Version of the software running on the Gateway.
- 4 **microSD Status:** Indicates the SD card is formatted correctly.
- 5 **Free/Capacity:** The amount of memory used and total available on the microSD card.
- 6 **Format microSD:** Select to format or reformat a microSD card.
- 7 **Channels in Use:** Access the Settings Menu for each device connected to the Gateway.
- 8 **Upgrade:** Indicates if an upgrade is available or if the latest version is running.
- 9 **Save:** Tap to save the Gateways settings.
- 10 **Back:** Tap to return to the previous screen.

## 6.2.5 Individual Channel Screen

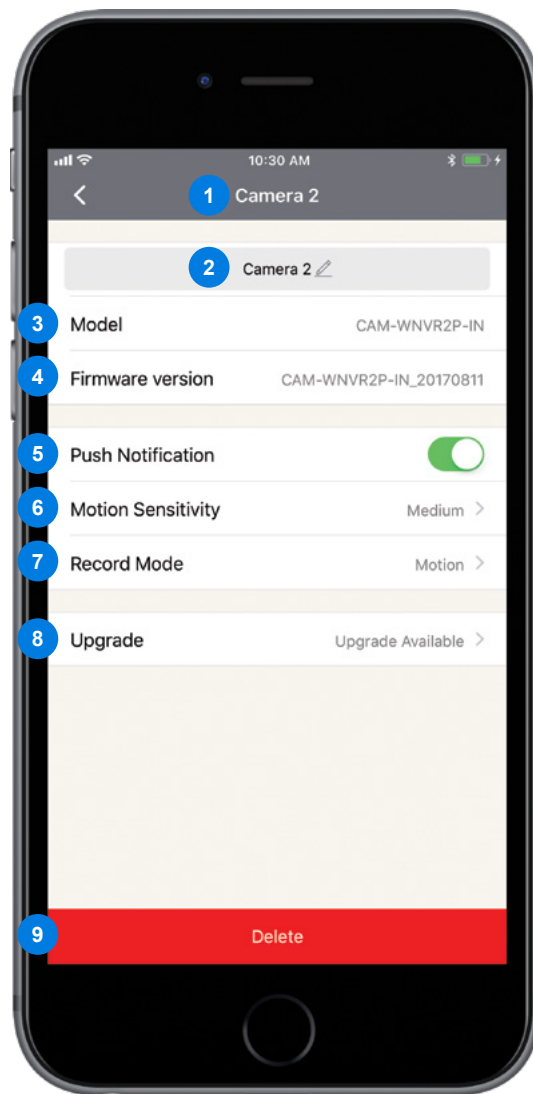


- 1 **Back:** Tap to return to the previous screen.
- 2 **Stream's Bitrate:** When switching from SD to HD, the bitrate will dramatically increase.
- 3 **Data:** Amount of data used in stream's transmission.
- 4 **Channel:** Name of the live view.
- 5 **Settings:** Tap to access the channels settings
- 6 **Playback Timeline:** Search for recordings based on time of day.
- 7 **Playback Scroll:** Scroll left to right to search for recordings.
- 8 **Playbacks:** Indicates a recording exists at that time.
- 9 **Zoom:** Tap to zoom in or out.
- 10 **Playback Date:** Day of the month.
- 11 **Capture:** Take a snapshot of the live stream.
- 12 **Record:** Manually record the live stream.
- 13 **Sound:** Tap to mute or unmute sound around the Night Owl device.
- 14 **Talk:** Press and hold to talk, release to listen. (Sound must be unmuted)

**NOTE:** Pressing and holding the “Talk Button” that appears on the live view screen, when audio is unmuted, allows the Night Owl audio enabled device to act as a Walkie Talkie.



## 6.2.6 Individual Channel Settings



- 1 **Channel:** Name of the live view.
- 2 **Edit:** Edit the channel's name.
- 3 **Model:** The model # of your Gateway.
- 4 **Firmware Version:** Version of the software running on the Gateway.
- 5 **Push Notification:** Enable/disable push notifications.
- 6 **Motion Sensitivity:** Adjust the motion sensitivity of the device to *Low*, *Medium*, or *High*.
- 7 **Recording Mode:** Select recording mode type.
- 8 **Upgrade:** Indicates if an upgrade is available or if the latest version is running.
- 9 **Delete:** Removes the paired device from the Gateway. The corresponding channel status light on the Gateway will turn off.

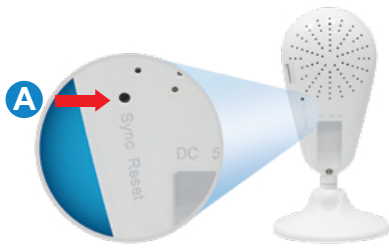
# Chapter 9: Troubleshooting

If a problem occurs, you may be able to easily correct it yourself. The following table describes some common issues and their most likely solutions. Please refer to the table before calling technical support.

## Camera(s) failed to pair to Gateway?

Insert the reset pin into the Sync/Reset hole **A** or press and hold the reset button **B** until you hear the camera say ***“Please be patient. Camera is resetting.”*** Once the camera resets, you will hear ***“Camera is in pairing mode”*** and the Status light will flash quickly.

**NOTE:** Reset one camera at a time.

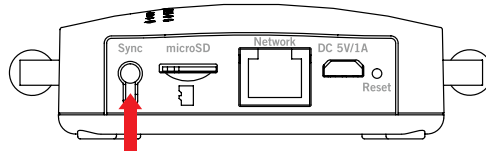

Once the Camera is in Pairing Mode, Press the Sync Button on the Gateway.

## Sync to other Night Owl Devices

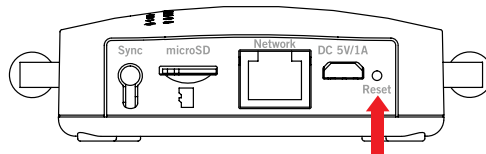
To sync the Gateway to a device, press and hold the sync button until the voice prompt says, ***“I am pairing to the Night Owl device, please be patient”***. If the synchronization fails, make sure the Night Owl device the Gateway is searching for is in pairing mode and try again.

**NOTE:** The Gateway and the Night Owl device **MUST** be on the same Network.



## Resetting the Gateway

To reset the Gateway to the factory default settings, insert the reset pin into the reset hole for 10 seconds.



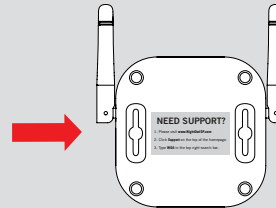
**CAUTION!** Resetting the Gateway to its factory default settings removes all connected devices from the Gateway. Seriously, this should be a last resort.
