Kitchen and Cooking Safety Yes __ No __ Do you stay in the kitchen when food is cooking on the stove? Yes __ No __ Are pot handles turned inward so they can't be bumped off or overturned? Yes __ No __ Do you make sure kitchen towels, pot holders and other things that can burn are kept away from the stove?
