


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## **USE AND CARE INSTRUCTIONS**



1. Locate the end-to-end connector and ground stakes of the first kit.




3. Save the power adaptor for future use.




5. Locate the end-to-end connector of the second kit. Open the protective cap to reveal the female connector.

**TIP:** For best signal quality/reception, make sure the controller is placed on a raised area free of obstacles.

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

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## **REMOTE CONTROL INSTRUCTIONS**



Remove insulation

tab before use.

- 1. Remove the insulation tab before use.
- 2. Tap (b) to turn lights ON or OFF.
- 3. Tap the Color Wheel to display all lights in one-color steady glow. Sweep around the color wheel to select your desired color.
- 4. Tap 🚳 to display all lights in cool white steady glow.
- 5. Tap o to display all lights in multi color steady glow.
- 6. Tap ▶| or I◀ to select from the 8 preset motion effects:
  - Strobe
  - · Chasing
  - Fading
  - Rainbow Chasing
  - · Stacking
  - Twinkle
  - Rotating
  - Dimple
- 7. Tap  $\gg$  or > to adjust the speed of motion effect.
- 8. Tap  $\dot{\phi}$  or  $\dot{\phi}$  to adjust the brightness of lights.

#### **Battery Replacement**

- 1. Slide open the battery cover.
- 2. Replace with a new CR2032 button cell battery with correct polarities (+/-) as indicated.
- 3. Slide the battery cover closed.
