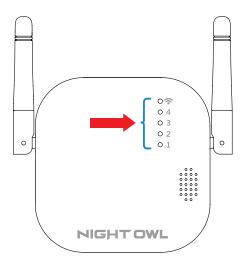


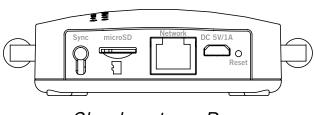




## **Status Light Keys**

#### **Gateway Status Light Key**





Check out my Rear

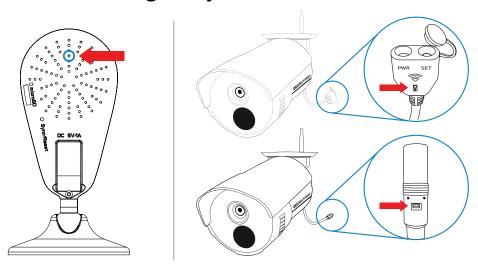
**Channel LED Light is Solid** – Camera is paired to a channel

**Channel LED Light is Flashing** – Camera is not paired to a channel

Wireless LED Light is Solid – Gateway is connected to the internet

Wireless LED Light is Flashing – Gateway is not connected to internet

#### **Camera Status Light Key**



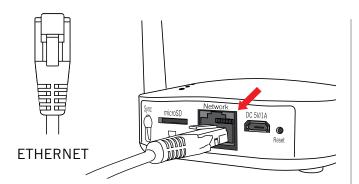
NOTE: Status Light location depends on camera version. Allow up to 2 minutes for the cameras to initiate. This is a perfect time to download the app!

**Quickly Flashing** – Pairing Mode (Default)

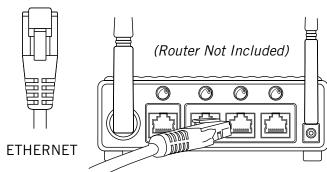
**Slowly Flashing** – Camera is not connected to the Gateway or Wi-Fi network

**Solid Light** – Camera is connected and functional

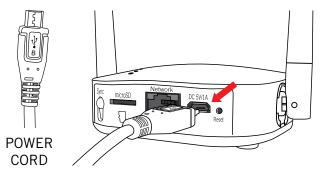
## **Connecting Your System**



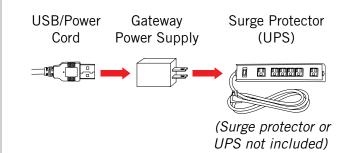
1 Plug one end of the included Ethernet cable into the Network port on the back of the Gateway.



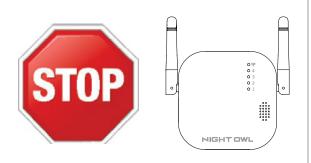
2 Plug the other end of the Ethernet cable into a port on the back of your router.



3 Connect the Gateway power cord to the Power Input on the rear of the Gateway.

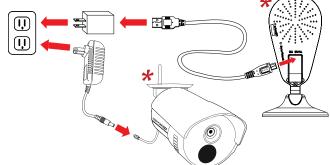


4 Plug the USB end of the Gateway power cord into the Gateway power supply. Plug the Gateway power supply into a surge protector or Uninterruptible Power Supply (UPS).



5 Relax for a moment as the Gateway initiates. Once the Gateway is connected to the internet and ready to be synced, move to step 6.

★ DISCLAIMER: May not be included depending on the model # purchased.



6 Power on each camera with its own power cord/supply.

**NOTE:** Allow up to 2 minutes for the cameras to initiate. This is the perfect time to download the app!

## **Using Night Owl Connect**



1 Download the app from the *App Store* or *Google Play Store* and install the application on your device.







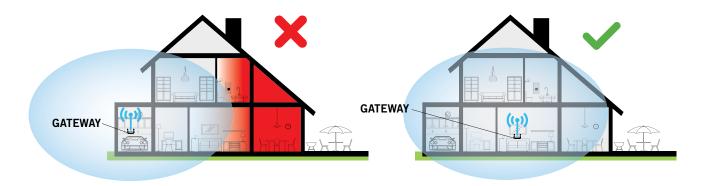


**NOTE:** Setup is the same for Smartphone and Tablet.

- 2 Create an account using an email address for the username and a password between 6–20 characters.
- 3 After completing the account setup and verification process, sign into the app and tap the "+" symbol to add a device.

The Night Owl Application will lead you through the rest of the setup process.

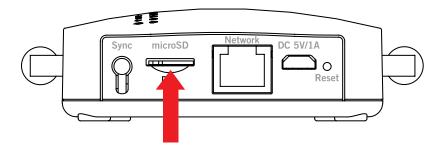
#### **Positioning Your Gateway**



Proper placement of the Gateway ensures maximum coverage for your property.

- Place in a central location
- Mount cameras within 300 Ft of the Gateway
- Keep it close to your Router, if possible

#### **Installing and Formatting Gateway SD Card**



- 1 Insert microSD card into the Gateway's SD card slot. (May not be included).
- 2 Open the app.
- 3 Open the live view.
- 4 Tap the settings icon.
- 5 Tap "Format SD Card".

## **Troubleshooting**

### Camera(s) failed to pair to Gateway?

Insert the reset pin into the Sync/Reset hole A or press and hold the reset button B until you hear the camera say "Please be patient. Camera is resetting." Once the camera resets, you will hear "Camera is in pairing mode" and the Status light will flash quickly.

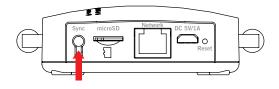


Once the Camera is in Pairing Mode, Press the Sync Button on the Gateway.

#### Sync to other Night Owl Devices

To sync the Gateway to a device, press and hold the sync button until the voice prompt says, "I am pairing to the Night Owl device, please be patient." If the synchronization fails, make sure the Night Owl device the Gateway is searching for is in pairing mode and try again.

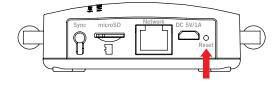
**NOTE:** The Gateway and the Night Owl device MUST be on the same Network. Before pairing, we recommend that you put the Night Owl device within 9ft from the Gateway.



#### Resetting the Gateway

To reset the Gateway to the factory default settings, insert the reset pin into the reset hole for 10 seconds.

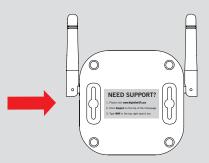
