

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### **Safety Information**

#### 1. SET UP YOUR GAZEBO PROPERLY

 $\square$  This unit is heavy. Do not assemble this item alone. 4 people are recommended for safe assembly.

 $\square$  Please read and understand this entire manual before attempting to assemble, operate, or install the product.

 $\square$  Keep all children, pets and other obstructions away from assembly area.

 $\hfill \square$  If any part is missing or damaged, do not attempt to assemble the product.

 $\square$  In order to avoid damage to the gazebo and its components please use appropriate tools.

 $\square$  Do not use the structure as support.

 $\hfill \Box$  Check all bolts on a regular basis to maintain the solidity of the structure.

 $\square$  Keep instructions for future use.

#### 2. EXAMINE YOUR GAZEBO

 $\square$  Examine occasionally to ensure there are no loose parts. If loose parts are found, they should be retightened immediately.



**DANGER:** This unit is heavy! Do not assemble this item alone.



WARNING: Do not leave the gazebo where there is a risk of high wind, as possible damage will occur to the structure.



**CAUTION:** Do not climb on top of the gazebo. Falling off the gazebo can result in serious injury, possibly even death.

#### WHAT IS COVERED

We provide warranty to the original purchase for 2 year for frame and 1 year for fabric from the date of purchase, and the fabric and frame will be replaced at no charge due to manufacturing defects.

#### WHAT IS NOT COVERED

We do not reimburse for transportation costs. This warranty does not cover the damage caused by commercial use, acts of nature, fire, freezing, and abusive use. Discoloration or fading of the finish or fabrics as a result of chemicals or spills is not covered.

### **Pre-installation**

#### PLANNING INSTALLATION

To prevent damage, place all parts on a soft surface during assembly.

Tools required for assembly (not included): Allen wrench (included), hammer, screwdriver, stepladder, level and other safety items such as gloves, safety goggles and hardhat.

## **Operation**

## Installing the Post

□ Insert the Base Cover (B) into Post (A), attach Post (A) to the Base (C) with Bolt (AA).




# 2 Inserting the Lintel

□ Insert the Right Lintel (D2) into the Lintel Cover (F), insert the Connector (E) into the Lintel (D2/D1).



**NOTE**: Please take note of the direction of lintel cover and Lintel (D1/D2).




## 3 Installing the Lintel and Connector

 Connect the Lintel (D1/D2) with the Connector (E) by bolt (AA), at the same time, connect the Connector (G1) and the Connector (E) by Bolt (AA) in the upper side.




NOTE: Please take note of Connector's direction.




## 4 Installing the Lintel and Post

 Attach the Right Lintel (D2) and the Left Lintel (D1) to Post (A) by Bolt (EE).




# 5 Installing the Support Bar

Attach the Left Support Bar (H1) to the Left Lintel (D1) and Post (A) by Bolt (AA); attach the Right Support Bar (H2) to the Right Lintel (D2) and Post (A) by Bolt (AA).




# 6 Installing the Corner Connector and Lintel

□ Attach the Corner Connector (F1) to the Lintel (D1/D2) by Bolt (AA).




## 7 Installing the Top Connector and Long Top Bar

Attach the Top Connector (G2) to the Long Top Bar (I1) by Bolt (AA).




## 8 Installing the Long Top Bar

- Attach the Long Top Bar (I1) to the Big Top Connector (J) by Bolt (AA).
- Attach the Top Connector (G2) located below the Long Top Bar (I1) to Post (A) by Bolt (AA).




# 9 Installing the Short Top Bar

- Attach the Short Top Bar (I2) to the Big Top Connector (J) by Bolt (AA).
- Connect the Connector (P1) and Connector (G1) to the end of Short TOP Bar (I2) by Bolt (AA).
- Connect other sides in the same way.




# 10 Installing the Center Connector and Small Top Bar

- □ Screw the Hook (L4) to the Center Connector (L1).
- Connect the Small Top Bar (K) with the Center Connector (L1) by bolts (DD).



## 1 1 Installing the Small Top Bar and Big Top Connector

 Attach the Small Top Bar (K) to the Big Top Connector (J) by Bolt (AA).




# 12 Installing the Small Top Panel and Roof Border

- Attach the Small Top Panel (R) to the Small Top Bar (K) by Bolt (AA). Assemble the others in the same way.
- □ Attach #3 Roof Borders (M3) to the edge of the roof as shown by Bolt (AA).



**NOTE**: To avoid destroying the finish, please handle it with care.




**13** Installing the Small Top Center and Small Top Cover

- Attach the Small Top Roof Cover (Q1) to the Small Top Bar (K) by Bolt (CC).
- Attach the Small Top Cover (L2) to the Center Connector (L1) by Finial (L3).



**NOTE**: To avoid destroying the finish, please handle it with care.




# 14 Installing the Roof Supports

Attach #1 Roof Supports (N1) to the Long Top Bar (I1) and the Short Top Bar (I2) by Bolt (AA). Attach #2 Roof Supports (N2) to the Short Top Bar (I2) and the Long Top Bar (I1) by Bolt (AA). Attach #3 Roof Supports (O1) and #4 Roof Supports (O2) to the Long Top Bar (I1) and the Short Top Bar (I2) in the same way.



**NOTE**: To avoid destroying the finish, please handle it with care.




# 15 Installing the Sliding Tube

 Insert one end of the Sliding Tube (P2) into the Connector (P1), attach the other end of the Sliding Tube (P2) to the Long Top Bar (I1) by Bolt (AA).



**NOTE**: To avoid destroying the finish, please handle it with care.




# **16** Installing the Big Top Panel

- Install the Roof Panels starting from left to right. Slide #1 Roof Panel (S1) into position. Then overlap #2 Roof Panel (T1) as shown and slide it into position. Attach #1 Roof Panel (S1) and #2 Roof Panel (T1) to #3 Roof Supports (O1) by Bolt (BB) and Spacer (X).
- Slide #3 Roof Panel (U) into position. Attach #3 Roof Panel (U) and #2 Roof Panel (T1) to #3 Roof Supports (01) by Bolt (BB) and Spacer (X).
- □ Slide #4 Roof Panel (T2) into position. Attach #4 Roof Panel (T2) and #3 Roof Panel (U) to #4 Roof Supports (O2) by Bolt (BB) and Spacer (X).
- Slide #5 Roof Panel (S2) into position. Attach #5 Roof Panel (S2) and
   #4 Roof Panel (T2) to #4 Roof Supports (O2) by Bolt (BB) and Spacer (X).
   Repeat on each side.
- □ Tighten all bolts (BB).
- Attach #1 Roof Borders (M1) and #2 Roof Borders (M2) to the edge of the roof as shown with Bolt (AA). Attach the Short Bar Connector (M4) as shown with Bolt (AA).



**NOTE**: Don't tighten the screws firstly untill all roof borders are installed.

- Assembled by 2 persons.
- Make sure each screw installed on this step is attached to a Spacer (X).
- Do not tighten the screws until all roof panels finish installation. If tighten them from the beginning, you will not be able to install all the roof panels properly.




17 Installing the Big Top Cover and Connector

- Attach the Big Top Panel Cover (Q2) to the Long Top Bar (I1) by Bolt (CC).
- □ Attach the Connector (Q3) to the Big Top Connector (J) by Bolt (AA).




**NOTE**: To avoid destroying the finish, please handle it with care.




# 18 Installing the Small Air Vent

Put the Air Vent (V) inside of the frame and attach the Air Vent (V) to the Long Top Bar by using the velcro straps.



# 19 Installing the Mosquito Net and Fixing the Gazebo

- Hang the Mosquito Net (W) onto the Sliding Tube (P2) by Plastic Ring (FF).
- Adjust position of gazebo and anchor posts to the ground by inserting the Stakes (GG) into each hole in each Base Plate.




## **Care and Maintenance**

□ For cleaning, use a mild detergent solution, rinse with water, and allow to air dry. Do not use acetone, abrasive, or other special detergents as they would be harmful to the product's finish.	
□ Due to the nature of steel, surface oxidation (rusting) will occur if this protective coating s scratched. This is a natural process. To minimize this condition, it is recommended that care be taken when assembling and handling the product in order to prevent the paint from being scratched.
