INSTRUCTION MANUAL

Important Safety Instructions

- Use this product only for its intended use as described in this manual.
- Do not allow children to use this product.
- If any part of the TopsyTurvy® tomato planter appears to be damaged or malfunctioning, discontinue use immediately.
- When the TopsyTurvy® tomato planter is full, it will be heavy. Use caution when lifting it and support it from the bottom.

Before You Start

- Purchase a tomato plant seedling and potting soil mix from your local gardening store. Tomato seeds will not work with the Topsy Turvy® tomato planter, and other types of soils are unsuitable.

- Find a suitable location to hang your Topsy Turvy® tomato planter.

 a. Make sure that the location has a solid wood surface that can be drilled into to hold the included hook, or if you have an existing hook, make sure that it will be able to withstand a minimum load of 50 lb.
 - Make sure the location has access to plenty of direct sunlight (minimum of 6 hours of afternoon sun), and a water source if possible.
- Drill a hole into the solid wood at the location you want to hang the Topsy Turvy® tomato planter, and screw the included hook into wood until completely secure.
 - DO NOT HANG IN SHEET-ROCK, VINYL SIDING, OR ANY OTHER NON-WOOD SURFACE/MATERIAL.
 - b. REMEMBER TO DRILL THE HOLE HIGH ENOUGH FOR THE PLANT TO GROW BELOW THE BAG.

Installation



Remove all components from the Topsy Turvy® tomato planter and hang the planter on the hook via the rotating top hook. NOTE: You may want to initially hang the Topsy Turvy® via a rope that can be temporarily lowered during installation.



Remove your tomato plant from its container, and VERY carefully, insert the root ball of the plant through the bottom of the planter's starburst port. Make sure the soil doesn't separate from the root ball.

Using a small bucket or shovel, carefully fill the planter with good quality potting soil mix a little bit at a time. Check the position of the tomato plant while filling to make sure it is still in place. Leave 4" of room at the top of the planter to allow space for the watering system. DO NOT pour soil directly into the planter all at once, as the root system will become damaged. system will become damaged.



Insert the watering system into the planter. Secure it by looping the hooks on the sides of the watering system to the metal ring of the planter. Place the lid on the by sliding the cables into the outer slots and pressing onto the metal ring. You are now ready to use your Topsy Turvy® tomato planter!

Watering

Once you have set up your Topsy Turvy® tomato planter, you will need to water it as frequently as once per day. This is especially important during dry or hot days.

- In order to water your tomatoes growing in the Topsy Turvy® tomato planter, completely fill the watering system with water daily.
- The watering system is able to hold up to 1 gallon of water, which will slowly drip water into the soil, keeping your tomatoes sufficiently watered throughout the day.

 Water more if the soil is dry and the leaves start to curl up Watering Amount or become wilted.
