

Safety Information

Read all instructions carefully before you begin this installation. Save the instructions for further reference.

RATINGS

- □ The 12 in. fixture with SKU#1002590038 is rated at 120V, 60Hz, 8.3W.
- The 18 in. fixture with SKU#1002631145 is rated at 120V, 60Hz, 11W.
- The 24 in, fixture with SKU#1002590033 is rated at 120V, 60Hz, 14.4W.
- Changes or modifications to this unit not expressly approved by the party responsible for compliance could void the user's authority to operate the equipment.
- This equipment has been tested and found to comply with the limits for a Class B digital device pursuant to Part 15 of the FCC Rules and ICES-005 of the IC Rules. These limits are designed to provide reasonable installation protection. This equipment generates and can radiate radio frequency energy and, if not installed and used in accordance with the instructions, may cause harmful interference.

However, there is no guarantee that interference will not occur in a particular installation. If this equipment does cause harmful interference to radio or television reception, which can be determined by turning the equipment off and on, the user is encouraged to try to correct the interference by one or more of the following measures:

- Do not operate this fixture with a missing or damaged cover or housing.
- 9. The LED source cannot be replaced.
- 10. Do not stare directly into LED source.
- 11. Do not dismantle or alter this fixture.



WARNING: Ensure the electricity is turned off at the main circuit breaker or fuse box. Do not attempt to install the fixture with the power on.



CAUTION: For indoor and dry location use only.



CAUTION: Do not mount this fixture near a heat source as it may damage this fixture.







Installation - Corner Mount


Marking the installation location


- Select a suitable dry mounting location (for indoor use only). Make sure the mounting surface is capable of supporting the fixture.
- Use the enclosed mounting template (AA) to mark the appropriate screw hole locations. Ensure the longest edge of the mounting template is attached firmly to the cabinet edge.



2 Installing the clips

 Install the left and right clips (BB and CC) in the marked locations with two mounting screws (DD).






3 Installing the fixture


Install the fixture (A) inside the clips (BB and CC).
Rotate the fixture to the desired angle.






Installation - Horizontal Mount

- Use the enclosed mounting template (AA) to mark the appropriate screw hole locations.








Installation - Vertical Mount

- Use the enclosed mounting template (AA) to mark the appropriate screw hole locations.







Plugging-In and Linking Lights




CAUTION: Do not attempt to attach additional fixtures to the existing system without unplugging the power cord from the electrical outlet or disconnecting the electricity at the electrical power panel.

NOTE: Number of fixtures that can be linked together:




- □ 12 in. A maximum of 11 fixtures can be connected together.
- 18 in. A maximum of 8 fixtures can be connected together.
- 24 in. A maximum of 7 fixtures can be connected together.
- 1. Attach the 5 ft. (1.52 m) power cord (B) with the plug and 3-pin quick connector to the fixture closest to the outlet.
- 2. Attach the 18 in. (45.72 cm) extension cord (D) with link connectors on both ends. It is used to connect the light fixture to the next one in your chain. Link to the adjacent fixture only. See the diagram below to see how the 2-pin and 3-pin plugs are intended to be used.
- 3. Remove the end cap (C) from the light to use the 18 in. extension cord (D).
- 4. Plug the fixture into a 120V/60Hz outlet. Turn on the switch to light the fixture.
- To install additional fixtures, first follow the mounting instructions. Once installed, attach the extension cord between the last fixture (previously installed) and the new one.
- When adding additional fixtures to an existing system of linked fixtures, the power cord is not required. Only the first fixture in the chain needs to be connected to the power with the power cord.




Luminous Intensity Distribution


12 in. LED Corner Light (57401-WH):
