WARNING!

Many parts of the grill will become very hot during operation. Care must be taken to avoid burns, both during operation and afterwards, while the grill is still hot.

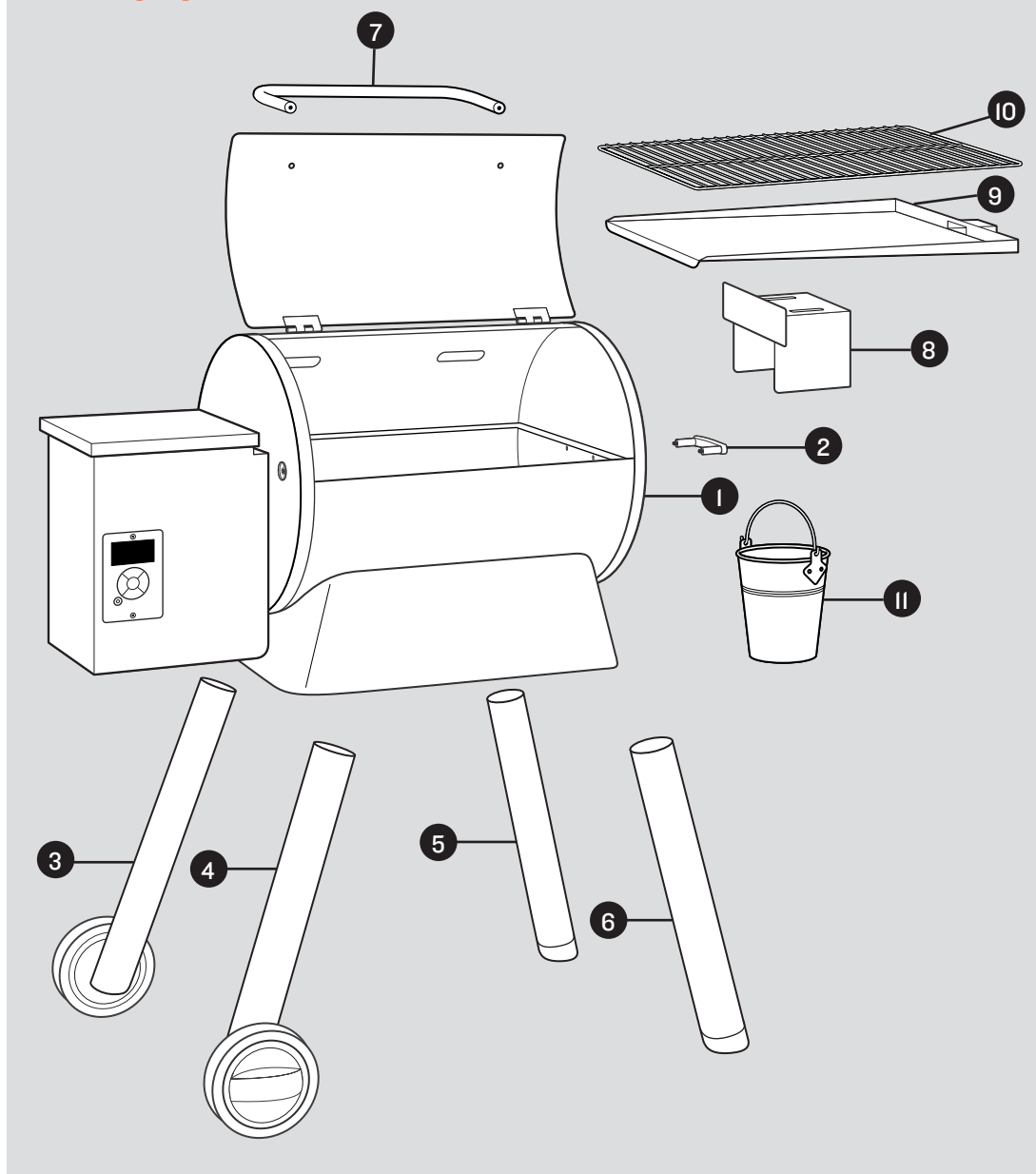
- Never leave the grill unattended when young children are present.
- Never move the grill when it is operating.
- Let the grill cool completely before moving or attempting to transport.
- **Grill is very heavy. Always lift grill with TWO people.**

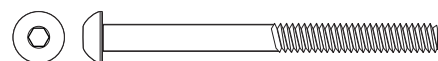

A Bolts: $\frac{5}{16}$ "-18 socket head (8 pcs)



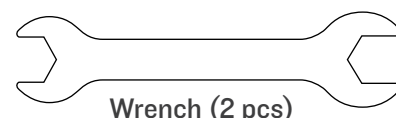
B Washers: $\frac{5}{16}$ " (16 pcs)



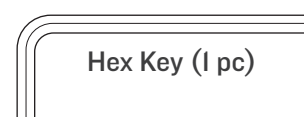
C Spring Washers: $\frac{5}{16}$ " (8 pcs)



D Hex Nuts: $\frac{5}{16}$ "-18 (8 pcs)

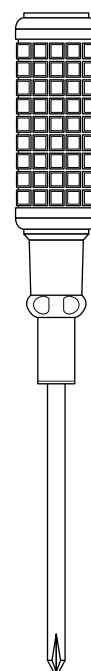


Wrench (2 pcs)

Screwdriver (1 pc)

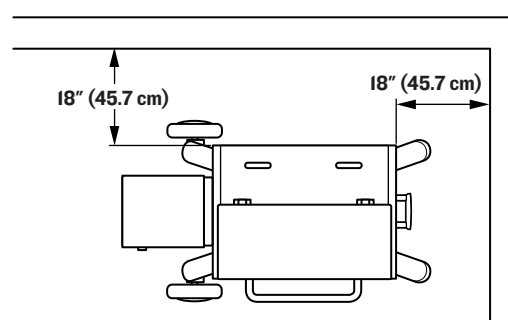
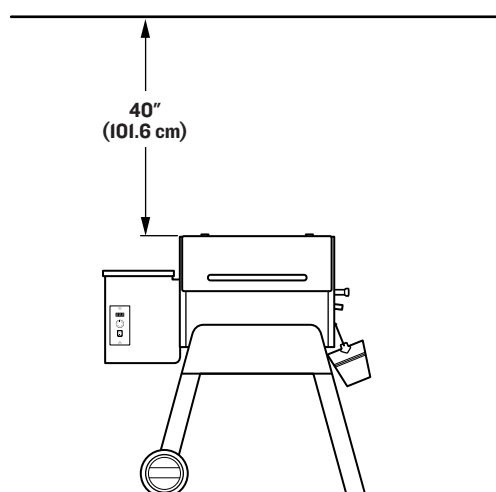


WARNING!

- When operating this grill under overhead combustibles, a **MINIMUM** of 40" (101.6 cm) is required.
- When operating this grill, maintain a **MINIMUM** distance of 18" (45.7 cm) from the grill to combustibles.

- The grill is very heavy. Always lift the grill with **TWO** people.






**GRAB THE 6-PACK, GET THE TOOLS, CUE THE RADIO —

NOTE: You should assemble grill on a clean, flat surface, as you will need to lay it upside down at different times during assembly.







Grill is very heavy. Always lift grill with TWO people.




