

# **OPERATION**

### CONNECTING THE NOISE SUPPRESSING **EARPHONES TO YOUR SMARTPHONE**



# **A** WARNING:

Do not insert earphones into ears before connecting to smartphone.

- Select and open the RYOBI<sub>™</sub> Phone Works<sup>™</sup> app.
- Insert the earphone plug into your smartphone's headphone jack.
- Turn the volume on your smartphone to its maximum setting.

**NOTE:** Some phones have features that limit the amount of volume available. Turn these features off before you attempt to use the device.

■ Open the NOISE SUPPRESSING EARPHONES App Segment.

#### **OPERATING TIPS**

See Figure 1.

Inserting the Noise Suppressing Earphones into your ears:


- Gently squeeze the foam earpiece to flatten slightly.
- Pull back on outer ear with one hand, insert the foam part of the earphone into the outer ear canal with the other hand.


NOTE: Earphones should be cleaned frequently with an antiseptic, such as isopropyl alcohol. Failure to clean earphones regularly can lead to ear infections. If a problem develops, discontinue use.

### USING THE NOISE SUPPRESSING EARPHONES See Figures 2 - 4.

NOTE: The earphones will amplify sounds up to a predetermined sound level, in which it stops amplifying and will deaden (block out) the sound.

■ To maximize noise suppression, make sure your hair is brushed away from your ears and the foam earpieces fit snugly in your ears.





## **OPERATION**

#### Suppressing sound:

- Tap the Settings icon to launch the settings menu.
- Select a level of noise suppression between 0 dB and 82 dB using the Cut-Off Amplitude slider.
- When finished, tap Done.

#### Adjusting the frequency to suppress sound:

Use the Low, Mid and High adjustments to fine-tune the frequencies of sound to be suppressed.

- Tap the Frequency icon.
- Select the frequency of sound to be adjusted.
- Use the Frequency Adjustment slider to fine-tune the level of suppression
- When finished, tap the "X" to exit.

**NOTE:** The adjusted settings will automatically be saved.

#### **Recording sound:**

You can record between 1 and 30 seconds of sound.

- Record sound by tapping the record button.
- Tap the button again to stop recording.

**NOTE:** The sound file will automatically be saved into the file cabinet. To access the file, select the file cabinet icon and navigate to the saved file.

#### MANAGING YOUR PROJECTS

### To edit, delete or share your images:

Tap the project name, a menu appears displaying **Add New**, **Edit**, **Use Existing** or **Cancel**.

#### **Add New**

- Tap **Add New** and enter the name of your new project.
- Tap **Done** to return to the screen. Any screen shots or pictures taken will be saved under this new project name.
- To review pictures, tap the file cabinet icon. Tap the picture to display the saved screenshot.

**NOTE:** If no pictures have been saved, you will receive a notice that no readings are available in this project. You must save a picture before you can open to review.

#### Edit


Delete the characters in the name and type the new name for the existing project.


#### **Use Existing**

- Scroll through the list of project names and select the one you wish to access.
- Tap **Done** to load the project.

#### **REVIEWING YOUR PROJECTS**

- Tap the file cabinet icon to review the pictures in the selected project.
- Swipe left or right to scroll through the pictures. The green arrow to the left of the project name returns you to the work screen.







- Tap the picture you wish to review.
- The preview picture is displayed.
- Tap the screen to enlarge the picture to full view. Tap again to reduce the picture.
- To share this picture, tap the share icon (<) in the top right of the screen. A blank email opens with the picture attached.
- To exit preview, tap the green arrow on the top left side of the screen.
- To delete a project view, swipe the screen image from right to left. The image will turn red. Tap **Delete** to permanently erase the image.

#### **CREATING NOTES**

Tap the notes icon in the projects screen. A menu appears displaying **Photos**, **Audio Memo**, **Location** and **Notes**.

- Tap plus (+) for **Photos** to take a picture in the selected project or to veiw current photos.
- Tap plus (+) for **Audio Memo** to record a voice memo of up to two minutes in the selected project. Tap the button to begin recording. Tap again to stop.
- Tap plus (+) for Location and select Use Current Location to record your current location in the selected project. To edit or manually enter the location, tap plus (+) again to access the keyboard.
- Tap plus (+) for **Notes** to access the notes screen. Tap plus (+) again to access the keyboard.

#### SHARING NOTES

- Select the share icon ( < )
- Select the share icon on each piece of data to be shared.
- Select the share method (e-mail or text).

### **PROJECT FOLDER SUMMARY**

See Figure 6

- The file cabinet may be accessed from the RYOBI<sub>™</sub> Phone Works<sup>™</sup> home screen or from any app segment.
- Accessing the file cabinet from the home screen will display all projects and icons representing the app segments used for each project.

#### PROJECT SUMMARY

- Accessing the file cabinet from within a project will display the app segments containing photos or data.
- Tap an icon to select or deselect an app segment within a project. When an app segment is selected, stored items will be visible.
- Tap a stored item to preview its details.

#### SHARING PROJECTS

- To share the picture, tap the share icon to the right of **Preview.** A blank email opens with the image attached.
- Tap **Cancel** to save the email as a draft or delete the draft. Sending the email returns you to the **Preview** screen.
- To exit preview, tap the arrow to the left of **Preview**.



#### **DELETING PROJECTS**

- To delete a project view, tap the trash can icon. Tap the project view(s) you wish to delete. A red trash can appears next to each item you have selected to delete. Tap **DELETE** Trap **DELETE** again to remove the item.
- To delete an entire project across multiple devices, return to the RYOBI<sub>™</sub> Phone Works<sup>™</sup> home screen. Select the file cabinet icon and then select the project you wish to delete. Swipe to reveal the **DELETE** option and select **DELETE**.

#### LISTENING TO AUXILIARY DEVICES



#### **WARNING:**

Adjust volume to desired level using the slider bar on the main NOISE SUPPRESSING EARPHONES screen.
