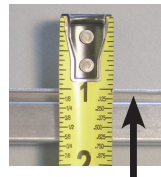


## SELECTING THE RIGHT SPLINE FOR YOUR SCREEN FRAME

- Measure spline groove on screen frame.
- The spline size should match the spline groove width, with product exceptions listed below.
- PetScreen®, TuffScreen®, SunTex® and Super Solar require one size smaller spline due to fabric thickness.
- Spline sizes shown in decimals to match fractional spline groove measurements in inches.
