


Check the vanity for damage before installation. If any parts of the vanity are missing or damaged, contact the Customer Service Team at 1-800-986-3460.


Ensure that the vanity location is accessible to water supply and drain lines. It is suggested that you rough-in the water lines and drain before installing the vanity.



Installation

Unpaking the countertop




DANGER: You will need at least two people to install this product properly.



CAUTION: During the unpacking and the handling of this vanity, note that the basin is not pre-glued to the frame.

- Unpack the countertop (B) from its vanity (C) and place it on a throw rug or other protective floor covering material to prevent damage to the countertop (B) or floor.
- □ Tear off the protective rubber strips above the vanity (C).




2 Attaching the countertop



CAUTION: Wear a pair of rubber gloves to protect your hands.


Apply lines of silicone onto the top of the vanity.



Installation (continued)


3 Attaching the countertop

□ Place the countertop (B) on top of the vanity (C).



4 Attaching the backsplash

- $\hfill\Box$ Wipe off the area on the top of the countertop (B) where the backsplash (A) will sit using a clean rag.
- Apply a line of silicone onto the bottom of the backsplash (A).
- Align the backsplash (A) with the back edge. Slowly lower it onto the countertop (B) and gently press to adhere.
- Wipe away any seeping silicone from underneath the backsplash (A) with a clean rag.
- □ Allow the vanity to dry for 24 hours before use.



Care and Cleaning

MARBLE VANITY TOP CARE AND CLEANING

- Liquid spills, such as alcohol, medications, etc should be cleaned up promptly. Some liquids with high-acid content can etch marble surfaces if left for any length of time. Popular products that should be promptly cleaned up are: shaving cream, toothpaste, perfume, cologne, nail polish remover, hair coloring and perm products, shampoo, drain opener, and toilet bowl cleaner.
- Place protective pads on the bottoms of any heavy objects, such as pottery, appliances, or other objects that may scratch the marble surface.
- Avoid abrasive cleaners or rough cleaning pads. If necessary, you can use a soft buffing pad.
- Use coasters under drinking glasses to prevent glass rings on the surface.
- □ Do not stand on the marble top to fix overhead lights or other items. Do not place extremely heavy items on the top.

CABINET CARE AND CLEANING

□ Clean with a furniture polish and a clean, soft, dry, lint-free cloth. Clean in the direction of the wood grain.
