



1 CONNECTING THE TABLE LEGS TO THE TABLE TOP

- Place the table top (A) upside down on a soft surface.
- Attach the table legs (B) to the table top (A) using M6x15 combination bolts (AA).




NOTE: Loosely tighten all the bolts using the hex wrench (CC).

2 CONNECTING THE LEG CONNECTOR TO THE TABLE LEGS

- Assemble the leg connector (C) to the table legs (B) using M6x25 combination bolts (BB).
- Once all of the bolts are in place, fully tighten the bolts using the hex wrench (CC).

3 COMPLETING THE ASSEMBLY

- Turn the table right side up
- Ensure all connections are secure before use.

- Attach the right arm (A) to the front of the glider bucket (C) using one M6x15 combination bolt (AA).
- Attach the top of the right arm (A) to the back of the glider bucket (C) using one M6x30 combination bolt (BB).
- Attach the back bar (D) to the right arm (A) using two M6x15 combination bolts (AA).



NOTE: Loosely tighten all bolts using the hex wrench (EE).





2 Connecting the left arm to the glider bucket and the back bar

- Attach the left arm (B) to the front of glider bucket (C) using one M6x15 combination bolt (AA).
- Attach the top of the left arm (B) to the back of the glider bucket (C) using one M6x30 combination bolt (BB).
- Attach the back bar (D) to the left arm (B) using two M6x15 combination bolts (AA).



NOTE: Loosely tighten all bolts using the hex wrench (EE).





3 Connecting the arms to the glider base

- Attach the glider base (E) to the arms (A and B) using four M6x18 countersunk bolts (DD) and plastic washers (CC).
- Glider base can install in any direction.





4 Tightening all bolts

- Turn the glider right side up.
- Once all bolts are in place, fully tighten all bolts.

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





NOTE: Loosely tighten all bolts using the wrench (EE).









- Attach the connection bars (E) to the left arm (B) and right arm (C) using M6x15 combination bolts (BB).






