How long has Mighty Max Cart been around?

We designed our latest cart and built our molds in 2009, then started fine-tuning the carts with production in 2010 in Texas.

<u>The Plus One Series Carts</u> have the same rust-free patented expandable flatbed and telescoping handle, plus our new Amphibious All-Terrain and Weatherproof wheels for outdoor use on all kinds of terrain like shallow sand, mud, gravel, jetties, uneven pavement -- and they can roll through salt water without damage to the wheels.

What are the primary materials your carts are made of?

The main frames are made of HDPP (High Density Polypropylene), a very rugged and flexible plastic that will never rust, oxidize, or permanently bend out of shape.

Our wheels have HDPP wheel hubs with no bearings to go bad and solid rubber tires that will never deflate and will always turn, even after rolling through salt water.

Our telescoping handle slides to a half-length, then turns underneath the cart base to make a small compact size, and it too is made of 100% HDPP. All Cargo Walls, Fishing Pole Holders, and Removable Tubs are also made of 100% HDPP.

Our hardware is unique as well, made of nylon and stainless steel for many years' use without rusting or oxidizing. Our steel axles are double coated with black oxide and last many years! We have carts in Hawaii with the original hardware and axles after six years' use.

How does the Plus One Cart work in sand?

Our new Amphibious and All-Terrain Wheels work very well in muddy, rocky, gravel, and packed sandy terrains.

We do not recommend the Plus One Cart in deep soft powdery sand. (Just like trying to walk on water, everything sinks in deep soft sand.)

Will these plastic carts warp or crack in hot and/or cold temperatures?

No, our cart frames are guaranteed for two years and, while they flex and bend under loads, they will then spring back to their original shape. If you leave your tub inside a car, or leaning crookedly in a closet or outdoors, and it warps, simply place the tub on a flat surface in sunshine while filling with water and it will rebound to its original shape. Be sure to store your Plus One Cart empty, preferably hanging it on a wall for best keeping.

Note: As with steel and aluminum, there are all kinds and qualities of plastic on the market. We use a special blend with the high impact HDPP with added special blends which allows the carts to flex under load and then spring back to normal shape. We have special blends that we add to the HDPP, which is how we can offer a 2-Year Warranty. We challenge you to find another all-purpose cart, caddy, and dolly on the market with a 2-Year Warranty, and our Direct "MADE IN USA" Customer Support.

What are the Mighty Max Plus One weight capacities?

The Plus One Cart with our Amphibious All-Terrain and Weatherproof wheels can haul up to 300 pounds on hard floors. On gravel, sand, and uneven pavement, we recommend a weight limit of 200 pounds.

How do I remove a wheel?

Our wheels are held on with a one-way licking end cap, which will assure the user that a wheel will never come off during normal operation. But if the need arises to replace a wheel or change out the type of wheels, here is what you do: Pop the plastic cap off the end cap with plyers or a flathead screw driver. Then bend the remaining metal retaining disk on one side towards you away from the cart. Then bend the opposite side of the disk also towards you and away from the cart. Then carefully pull the bent disc back and forth while pulling it off the axle. It will come off, but we made it difficult for a very good reason.

What is the maximum weight on the Plus One Cart on deep soft sand?

We do not recommend using the Plus One in deep soft sand. It does work well on packed sand, wet sand, gravel, and rocky and muddy terrain. Everything sinks in deep soft sand, even the human foot.

What are the weight limits for the Mighty Max Plus One flatbed in closed and fully opened positions?

Plus One Cart with All-Terrain Wheels:

Closed position:

- 300 pounds on concrete and solid flooring.
- 200 pounds on gravel, mud, and soft ground.

Fully Opened Position:

- 200 pounds with load spread evenly over entire length of the expanded cart base.
- 125 pounds on gravel, mud, sand and lose dirt.

Proper Storage of the Mighty Max Plus One Cart?

If you leave a heavy load on the cart and allow it to sit for several days or weeks, your wheels may form some small flat spots on them when you roll it. If this happens, please empty the cart, and turn it upside down in direct sunlight. The flat spots will pop out in a few hours. Just like car tires, if a vehicle is left in storage or outside without use for weeks or months, they will get dry rotted and have to be replaced.

We recommend that, for long periods of time, you store your Plus One Cart empty in a car trunk, or in a garage, storage area, or closet, or hang it on a wall. Our wheels are truly great, but constant exposure to sunlight, salt air, or harsh weather, can cause them to crack over time. We do offer replacement wheels.

Do I still get a Free Hitch if Buy Two or More Mighty Max or Plus One Carts?

Yes, if you purchase any two of our carts at one time we will send you a FREE Hitch Assembly to connect both of your carts, or to connect a cart behind a riding mower or 4-Wheeler.
