

### **Pre-Installation**

#### PLANNING INSTALLATION


Read all instructions before installation. Before starting installation of this fixture or removal of a previous fixture, disconnect the power by turning off the circuit breaker or by removing the fuse at the fuse box.

This fixture can be installed two ways: 1) onto a keyless lamp holder, or 2) onto an outlet box. Both installation options are described in this manual. This Guide will first show how to install the fixture onto a keyless lamp holder. This Guide will then show how to install the fixture onto an outlet box.







## Installation to a Keyless Lamp Holder


# 1 Preparing lamp holder for installation

<sup>n</sup> Remove existing bulb.



# Attaching the fixture to the keyless lamp holder


Screw the threaded base (A) clockwise into the keyless lamp holder (not included).



### Installation to an Outlet Box


## 1 Attaching the mounting bracket to the outlet box

Mount the mounting bracket (DD) to the outlet box using the two outlet box screws (BB).




## 2 Making the electrical connections

- Wrap the ground wire from the outlet box around the ground screw (FF) on the mounting bracket (DD).
- <sup>n</sup> Connect the white wire from the socket (EE) to the white wire from the outlet box.
- Connect the black wire from the socket (EE) to the black wire from the outlet box.
- Wrap the wire connections with electrical tape for a more secure connection.
- Cover the wire connections using the wire connectors (AA).
- <sup>n</sup> Position the wires back inside the outlet box.



# 3 Attaching the threaded base to the socket


Screw the threaded base (A) clockwise into the socket (EE).



### Installation to an Outlet Box (continued)


## 4 Attaching the fixture body to the outlet box

- Screw the mounting screws (CC) into the mounting bracket (DD).
- <sup>n</sup> Place the fixture body (B) over the outlet box.
- Allow the heads of the mounting screws (CC) to come out through the large ends of the keyholes on the fixture body (B).
- Turn the fixture body (B) clockwise until the heads of the mounting screws (CC) slide into the narrow ends of the keyholes on the fixture body (B).
- <sup>n</sup> Tighten the mounting screws (CC) to secure the fixture body (B).



# 5 Attaching the shade to the fixture body


- Align the slots on the shade (C) with the divots on the fixture body (B).
- Carefully turn the shade (C) clockwise until it locks into place.
- The shade (C) only turns about 1/8 of a turn. Do not over tighten.



### Pull Chain Option (Pull chain model only)

# 1 Attaching the string to pull chain

Insert the knot (GG) of the 36 inch string into the pull chain link and adjust to required length.



## Care and Cleaning



CAUTION: Before attempting to clean the fixture, disconnect the power to the fixture by turning the breaker off or removing the fuse from the fuse box.

Clean the fixture with a soft, dry cloth.

Do not use any cleaners with chemicals, solvents, or harsh abrasives.

### Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
The fixture will not light.	The power is off.	Ensure the power supply is on.
	The circuit breaker is off.	Ensure the circuit breaker is in the on position.
The fuse blows or the circuit breaker trips when the light is turned on.	The wires are crossed or the power wire is grounding out.	Check the wire connections. Contact a qualified electrician or call the Customer Service Team at 1-877-527-0313.

#### For Pull Chain models only:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
The fixture will not light.	The pull chain is not in the "On" position.	Ensure the pull chain from the lamp holder is in the "On" position before attaching the fixture to the lamp holder.



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Retain this manual for future use.
