WARNING: Don't assemble until ready, Included Fasteners can only be installed/used once.

ASSEMBLY:


- 1. Push U-Clip onto Brace & align with the small hold on the center channel.
- 2. Partially turn Thumb Screw into U-Clip & hole (see "thumb screw in u-clip" image).
- Push both Fasteners into Brace only (NOT the Shield, only into the Brace).
 Pushing fasteners into the shield at this point will make the shield uninstallable.

INSTALLATION:

- Hold Shield in position against J-Arm and align Brace for best fit. Position as high as possible (see image below). NOW, you can safely Snap together the Shield with the Brace.
- 2. Tighten the Thumb Screw to secure in place.

Note: The thumb screw is NOT intended to enter/penetrate any holes in the J-arm, it merely presses against it to hold in place.

*Optional - loop the emergency rope behind the Thumb Screw to further secure it out of reach. This is not required as the rope would be very difficult to reach with the Shield in place. *NOTE that UL Code 325 requires rope handle to be no further than 6 feet distance from the floor.

I lost a fastener, where do I get more?

Fasteners are available for sale from our website for \$.95 each plus S/H. Optionally, they are also available at ACE Hardware for the same price.

Is there a removable solution?

Use a standard bolt and nut INSTEAD of using the 2 included Fasteners. Be sure to use a lock washer or else it might rattle loose.

Do I need tools or special knowledge?

No, the Garage Shield was designed to be installed without tools and minimal effort. It should not take you more than a few seconds, a few minutes at most, to install.

Can I use a Zip Ti as well?

NO, the garage door industry has been lobbying people to remove zip ties for years. It was poorly given advise as it renders your EMERGENCY EXIT inoperable. Should something unspeakable happen, you not only put people at risk, but also risk having insurance claims rejected because you tampered with emergency exit design.

Huh? I don't have a J-Arm, now what?

Some rare garage doors don't have J-arms. The exploit is only for garage doors with that component. If you don't have it, the Garage Shield is not necessary. Contact us for a full refund.
