Assembly Steps

Step 1



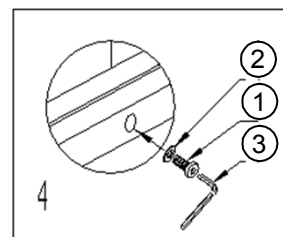
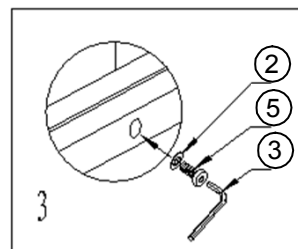
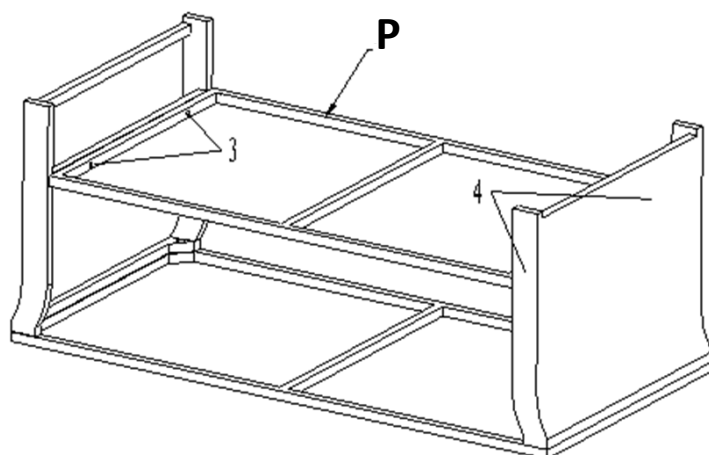
Place the Table Top(O) facedown on a soft non-marring surface.

Attach Table Legs(R) to Table Top(O) using Hardware(⑤, ②) with Allen Key as shown in Picture 1 and Picture 2.

DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN.

ATTENTION: Occasionally some of the PE wicker shifts and covers the mounting positions preventing easy assembly; the PE wicker should never be cut, but moved away from the mounting positions.

Step 2

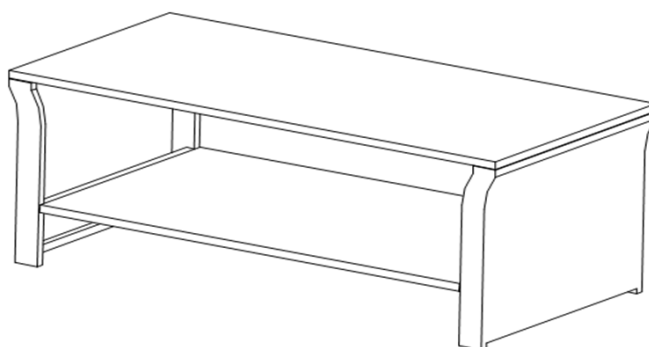


Attach the Table Shelf(P) between the two Table Legs(R) using Hardware(⑤ , ②) with Allen Key(③) as shown in Picture 3 and Picture 4.

Note: You may need a second pair of hands to hold the Table Shelf steady.





















Tighten all bolts at all joints completely.

Step 3



Now your table is ready for use.

Care & Maintenance

Overview

Please read through the instructions herebelow to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1



Open the carton and place all the parts onto a clean and soft surface.

Unpack all packages of hardware.

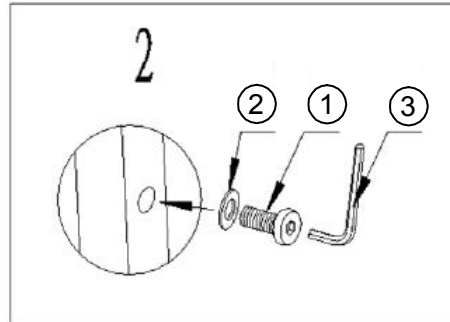
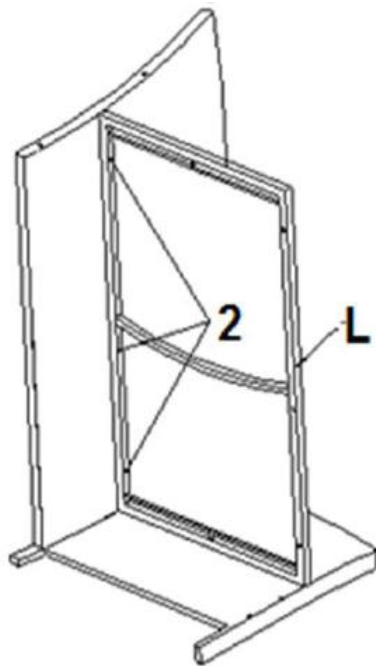
Place the Right Armrest (C) with its inside facing skywards.

Attach Backrest(K) to Right Armrest(C) using Hardware(①, ②) with Allen Key(③).

Do not fully tighten the bolts at this stage.

Occasionally some of the PE Wicker shifts and covers the mounting positions preventing easy assembly. The PE wicker should never be cut, but moved away from the mounting positions.

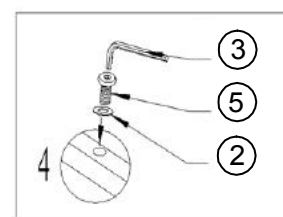
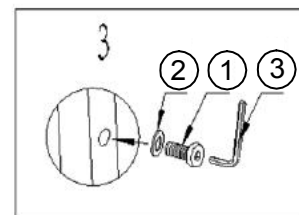
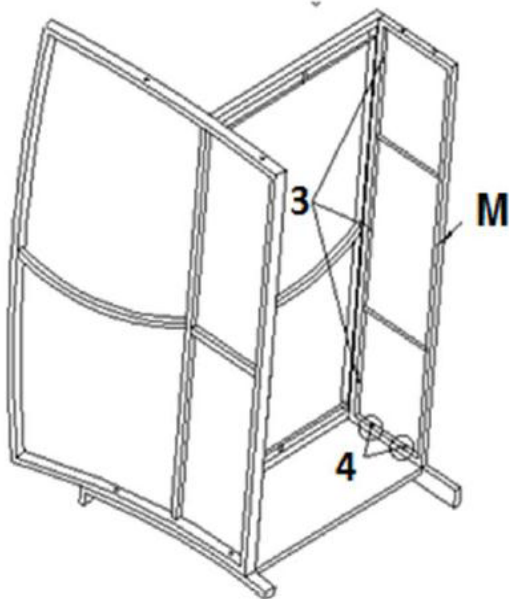
Step 2



Place the Seat(L), as picture above so as to be attached to the Right Armrest(C) and Backrest(K) using hardware ((1) . (2)) with Allen key((3)) as shown in picture 2.

Do not fully tighten at this stage.

Step 3

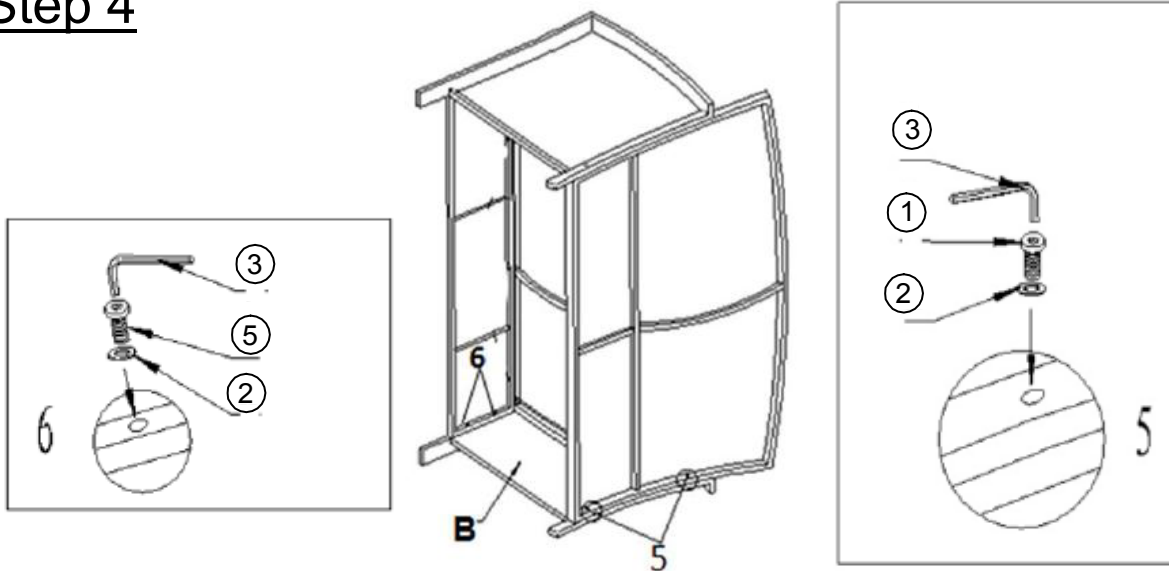


Place the Front Panel(M) as pictured above and affix to Seat (L) and Right Armrest(C).

Attach Front Panel(M) to Seat(L) using Hardware((1) (2) (5)) with Allen Key((3)) as shown in Picture 3 and Picture 4.

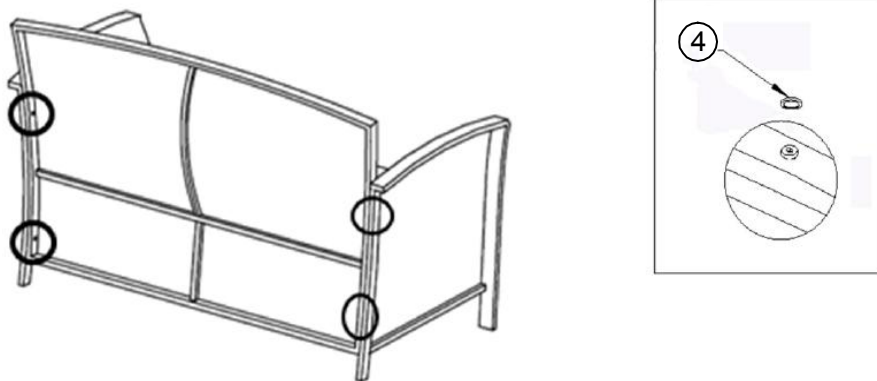
Do not fully tighten the bolts at this stage.

Step 4



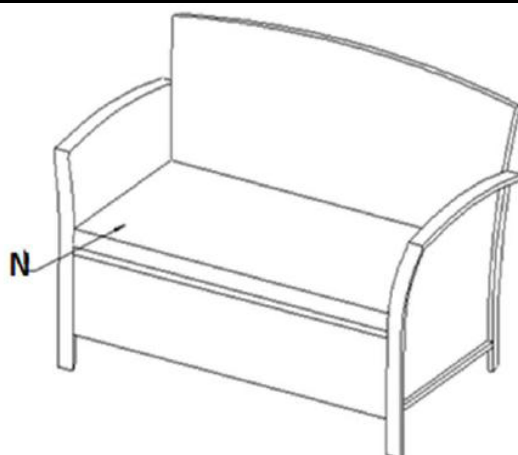
Place Left Armrest(B) against Backrest(K), Seat(L) and Front Panel(M).
 Attach the Left Armrest(B) to Backrest(K) using Hardware(①, ②) with Allen Key(③) as shown in Picture 5.
 Attach Left Armrest(B) to Front Panel(M) using Hardware(②, ⑤) with Allen Key(③) as shown in Picture 6.
Do not fully tighten the bolts at this stage.

Step 5























Fully tighten all bolts at all joints, then cover the four Backrest Bolts with Nut Cap (①).

Step 6



Put the Seat Cushion(N) on the Loveseat.

Step 2



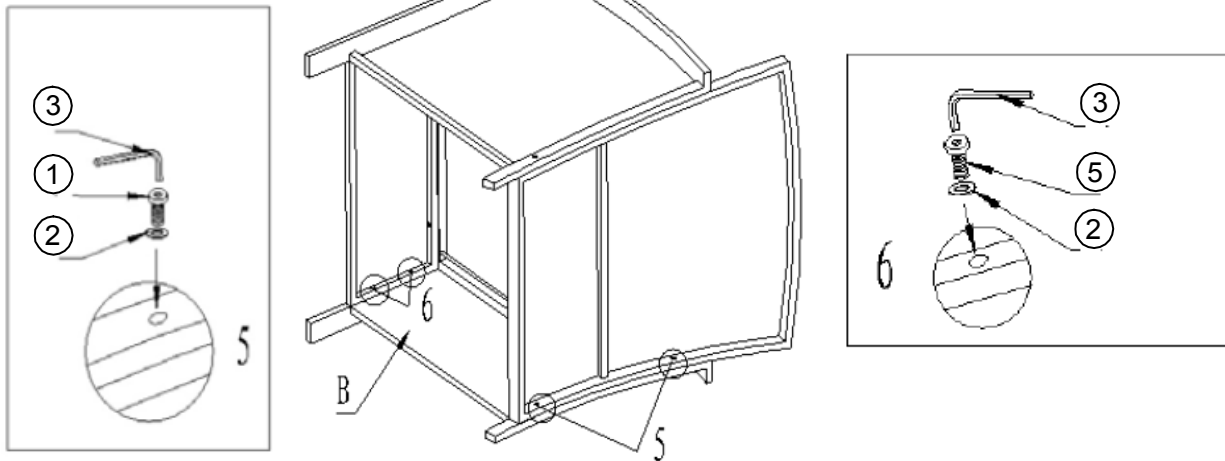
Place the Seat(D) between the Right Armrest(C) and Backrest(A).
 Attach Seat(D) to Right Armrest(C) using Hardware(① , ②) with Allen Key(③).
Do not fully tighten the bolts.

Step 3



Place Front Panel(E) between Seat(D) and Right Armrest(C).
 Attach Front Panel (E) to Seat(D) using Hardware(①②⑤) with Allen Key(③) as shown in Picture 3 and Picture 4.
Do not fully tighten at this stage.

Step 4



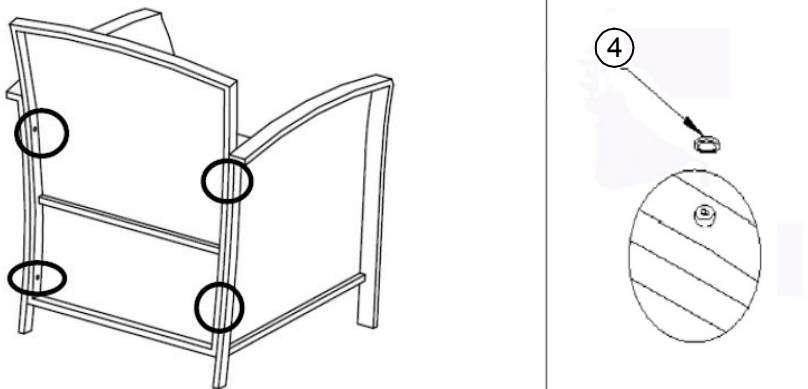
Place Left Armrest(B) against Backrest(A), Seat(D) and Front Panel(E).

Attach the Left Armrest(B) to Backrest(A) using Hardware (① , ②) with Allen Key(③) as shown in Picture 5.

Attach Left Armrest(B) to Front Panel(E) using Hardware(② , ⑤) with Allen Key(③) as shown in Picture 6.

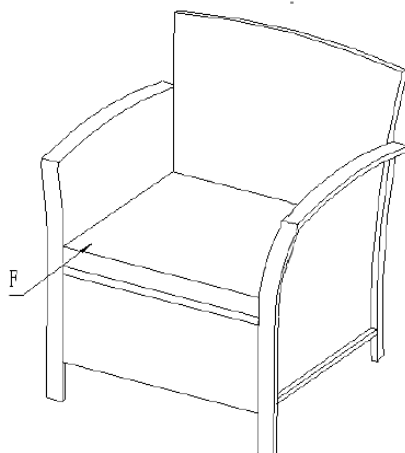
Do not fully tighten at this stage.

Step 5



Fully tighten all bolts at all joints, then cover the four Backrest Bolts with Nut Cap (④).

Step 6























Put the Seat Cushion(F) on the Single Sofa.

Your Single Sofa is ready for use.

The Single Sofa can only be used on a flat and level surface.
