

**CAUTION:** Inspect the wire insulation for any cuts, abrasions, or exposed copper that may have resulted during shipping. If there is a defect in the wire, do not attempt installation. Please call our Customer Service Team at 1-855-HD-HAMPTON.



WARNING: Before starting installation of this fixture or removal of a previous fixture, disconnect the power by turning off the circuit breaker or by removing the fuse at the fuse box.

## Warranty

The manufacturer warrants this lighting fixture to be free from defects in materials and workmanship for a period of one (1) year from date of purchase. This warranty applies only to the original consumer purchaser and only to products used in normal use and service. If this product is found to be defective, the manufacturer's only obligation, and your exclusive remedy, is the repair or replacement of the product at the manufacturer's discretion, provided that the product has not been damaged through misuse, abuse, accident, modifications, alterations, neglect, or mishandling. This warranty shall not apply to any product that is found to have been improperly installed, set-up, or used in any way not in accordance with the instructions supplied with the product. This warranty shall not apply to a failure of the product as a result of an accident, misuse, abuse, negligence, alteration, faulty installation, or any other failure not relating to faulty material or workmanship. ## Installation


# **1** Assembling the light fixture

- ☐ Attach the top loop to the top of the light fixture (A).
- ☐ Spread the arms of the light fixture (A) evenly.
- ☐ Attach the center column to the base of the light fixture (A).
- ☐ Attach the center column to the top of the light fixture (A).



# 2 Attaching the mounting unit and canopy to the junction box


- Attach the mounting unit (AA) to the junction box (not included) with the mounting screws (BB) and remove the pre-installed screw collar ring.
- □ Place the canopy (B) over the pre-installed screw collar loop on the mounting unit (AA). Turn the screw collar ring until 1/2 of the screw collar loop threads are exposed.
- ☐ Use a pair of pliers and a screwdriver (not included) to open the end link of the chain (D). Use a cloth on the pliers to protect the finish. Secure the chain (D) to the screw collar loop on the mounting unit (AA) and the top loop of the light fixture (A). Lower the screw collar ring and canopy (B) over the chain (D).
- □ Weave the electrical wires, ground wires and safety cable through the chain (D), screw collar loop, canopy (B) and through the center of the mounting unit (AA).




## **Installation (continued)**

# 3 Making the electrical connection

- Connect the copper wire on the light fixture (A) to the mounting unit (AA) by securing it with the pre-installed ground screw.
- ☐ Connect the black to black (power), the white to white (neutral) and copper wire to ground wire with the wire nuts (CC) and secure with electrical tape (not included).









NOTE: If the wires from the fixture are the same color, attach the side with markings or letters to the black (positive) wire and the other to the white (neutral) wire.

# 4 Securing the light fixture


- ☐ Secure the canopy (B) to the mounting unit (AA) with the screw collar ring.
- □ Secure support wires by inserting them into the nipples on the top of the light fixture (A).





# 5 Installing the light bulb and shade

- Remove the pre-installed socket rings, add shades (C) and re-secure the socket rings.
- ☐ Install five 60-watt max. medium-base incandescent bulbs or compatible CFL bulbs (not included).



# **Operation**

# 1 Turning the light on

 $\hfill\Box$  Turn the light switch on to activate the fixture.

# **Care and Cleaning**

- ☐ Clean the lamp with a soft, dry cloth.
- $\ \square$  Do not use any cleaners with chemicals, solvents, or harsh abrasives.

# **Troubleshooting**

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
The bulb will not light.	The bulb is burned out.	Replace the light bulb.
	The power is off.	Ensure the power supply is On.
	There is a faulty wire connection.	Check the wiring.
	The circuit breaker is off.	Ensure the circuit breaker is in the On position.
The fuse blows or circuit breaker trips when the light is turned on.	There are crossed wires or the power wire is grounding out.	Check the wire connections.  Contact a qualified electrician or call the Customer Service Team at 1-855-HD-HAMPTON.
