

- Do not overtighten connectors (screws, bolts, etc.).
 Overtightening can lead to product damage.
- Be sure to check all packing materials carefully for small parts that may have come loose inside the carton during shipment. If parts are missing, contact THE HOME DEPOT to obtain any missing parts.
- DO NOT USE SUBSTITUTE PARTS.
- This product should only be used on a flat, level surface.
- Some assembly may involve attaching glass or mirrors.
- Be very careful handling the glass or mirrors, as severe injury may result if the glass or mirror breaks.
- Never handle large pieces of glass or mirrors by yourself.
- Assembly requires two people; assembly alone may cause injury.



Pre-assembly

PLANNING ASSEMBLY

- $\hfill\square$ Remove all Packaging materials , staples and packing straps form the carton .
- $_{\Box}$ Refer to Parts List and Hardware List , and ensure parts and hardware are correct before assembly .
- $\hfill\square$ Contact customer service for missing parts .
- Place all wooden parts on a clean , flat , and soft surface (e.g.carpet or rug) to prevent scratch and damage to parts .





Assembly


Connect 4 legs to pedestal pillar


Turn pedestal pillar (C) over , insert 4 legs (D) to the hole in pedestal pillar (C) with wooden dowel (GG) .




Assembly (continued)

- 2 Fasten 4 legs pedestal pillar
- $\hfill\square$ Put the washer (CC&DD) with nut (EE) to the screw on legs (D) .
- Use wrench (GG) to tighten nut (EE).






3 Connect support bar (B) and support bar (E) as shown .



Assembly (continued)

4 Connect cross support bar to pedestal base from step 3


- Put the support bar (B) and support bar (E) to pedestal base top , make sure the 4 holes on support bar holes to be line up on the same axis where pedestal base as shown .
- $\hfill\square$ Insert the 4 screws (BB) ,tighten them with allen key (FF) .



Assembly (continued)

${\bf 5}$ Assemble table top to the base frame from step 6

- Dut the table top (A) to the base frame from step 6, make sure the holes line up with the holes on support bar (B) & (E) as shown
- Use 8 screws (AA) tighten the table top (A) and the support bar (B) with allen key (FF).



Maintenance

- $\hfill\square$ Keep the product away from direct heat and sunlight .
- \square Prolonged exposure to heat sources may cause scorching, or even cause color to fade .
- □ Regular vacuuming or light brushing helps to remove dirt and prevent soil build-up, which increases the appearance of wear .
- Periodically (every 90 days) make sure that the screws arefully tightened .

Care and Cleaning

- □ Handle with care.
- \Box Use a slightly damp cloth to clean the product. Do not use bleach or use abrasive cleaning material .
- □ Check all the fittings periodically and re-tighten as necessary. Do not us the product if any of the parts are damaged or broken .
- □ Never allow any kind of liquid to remain on your furniture .
- □ Absorption can make wood wrap or delaminate .
- $\hfill\square$ Do not place hot items (e.g. hot drinks) directly onto the wood surface.
- $\hfill\square$ Do not drag and /or pull the furniture .
- □ Never use harsh chemicals or solvents on your product as this may damage the metal .
- □ Marks and stains from pens, crayons and ink markers are difficult to remove. In the event that your products become permanently stained, we recommend that you consult a professional.
