#### **DESCRIPTION AND USES**

Watco<sup>®</sup> Rejuvenating Oil is a special oil designed for the care and restoration of oil-finished woods. Periodic use of Watco Rejuvenating Oil restores beauty to oil-finished wood by removing surface grime and creating a renewed luster and protection. Rejuvenating Oil replenishes dried out wood and leaves a pleasant lemon scent. It is suitable for use on furniture, trim, paneling or any oil-finished wood surface. It is not recommended for floors or exterior surfaces.

### PRODUCT APPLICATION

#### **SURFACE PREPARATION**

Watco Rejuvenating Oil will dissolve wax so there is no need to strip waxed wood before applying.

If sanding of the wood surface is required, prepare by sanding in the direction of the grain. Begin with #120 grit sandpaper and progress though #150, #180 and #220 grits. Remove all sanding dust and dirt with a vacuum, tack cloth, or rag dampened with mineral spirits.

## PRODUCT APPLICATION (cont.)

#### **APPLICATION**

Use only when air (ambient) temperature is between 60-90°F (16-32°C) and relative humidity is below 85%. Allow for longer dry times during damp and humid conditions. Gently shake the container to ensure thorough mixing of contents. Do not thin. Apply Rejuvenating Oil with a soft lint-free cloth. Wait 10 minutes and wipe the surface clean and dry with a soft cloth.

To remove minor surface stains and scratches, apply Rejuvenating Oil with fine steel wool or synthetic steel wool in the direction of the wood grain.

#### **WAXING**

For a rich, soft satin luster, apply Watco Satin wax for finishing after the oil has been allowed to dry for 72 hours.

#### **CLEAN UP**
