
Van Zyverden's TUBEROSES POLIANTHES DOUBLE BLOOMING

Deer and critter resistant.

Prefers a warm spot in full sun About This Variety: While noted for its beauty and ivory elegance, it is the delightful fragrance that makes it special. It will give your house that flower shop freshness.

Growing Instructions: Plant in spring after the weather is relatively warm. Avoid muddy areas as they don't like wet feet.

Care Tip: In northern locations plant in a protected sunny location. In zones 8 and above they can be left in the ground year around.

Exposure: Full sun to partial shade *Height:* Grows 30" Tall *Spacing:* Plant 8-12" apart, 3" deep *Hardy in:* USDA zones 7-10
