


## Z-FLASHING

Z-Flashing is used to keep water from getting through the horizontal joints between sheets of exterior siding.



- 1. Starting at either end of the wall, place the seat section of the Z-Flashing onto the top edge of the siding panel; the longer wall flange should be tight up against the wall.
- 2. Secure the flashing to the framing with 2-1/2 inch nails at each wall stud. Keep the nails toward the top edge of the flashing, do not penetrate the seat or face.
- 3. Overlap the ends a minimum of 2 inches. Cut the Z-flashing using aviation snips or a hacksaw.

These basic installation guidelines are for use with typical or standard applications. It is always recommended to seek advice from a licensed professional, and to check with your local building inspector or building permit office for approvals and possible variations that may apply.
