

TYPICAL FLASHING DETAILS




1 Ridge Cap




3 Valley Flashing

- 3. Specific flashing details available upon request.






4 Change-in-Pitch

- Open ends of flashings may be closed with matching sheet metal plugs (field fabricated) at ridge, hips, gable and similar flashings.
