

# Maintenance

#### **REPLACING THE BATTERY**



**NOTE:** Use one Li-ion 18650 Lithium battery, 2000mAh, 3.7V rechargeable battery pack. For best performance, replace with a Lithium rechargeable battery pack after 470 uses; normally every year, based on individual usage.



**NOTE:** To reduce the risk of damage to the electrical connections, exercise caution when separating the battery compartment base and cover.




**IMPORTANT:** Dispose of the battery in accordance with local, state and federal regulations.



**IMPORTANT:** When storing this gazebo, remove the plate from the top, and store it on a cool and high place, to increase service life.

- □ Loosen the two lock screws on the base and remove the cover from the base.
- □ Remove the old battery pack from the compartment and replace with a new 18650 Lithium battery, 2000mAh, 3.7V rechargeable battery pack.
- $\hfill\square$  Lock the base and cover with two screws.
- □ During first use, the light might not work. Please leave the gazebo under the sun to charge the solar plate.
- □ Leave the gazebo in a sunny place to extend lighting duration.




#### **PLANNING ASSEMBLY**


#### Assembling the long support bars

□ Connect the two long support bars (B) using M6x15 bolts (AA), nuts (BB), washers (CC) and fixed components (P).




## **2** Assembling the short support bars

□ Connect the two short support bars (C) using M6x15 bolts (AA), nuts (BB), washers (CC) and fixed components (P).




#### **3** Attaching the long support bars to the posts

□ Connect the long support bars (B) to the posts (A) using M6x15 bolts (AA) and washers (CC) at each corner.



#### Attaching the short support bars to the posts


□ Connect the long support bars (C) to the posts (A) using M6x15 bolts (AA) and washers (CC) at each corner.





#### Assembling the top connector bar

- □ Insert the wire connector on the long top bar (D) into the connector on the top center connector (H).
- $\hfill\square$  Insert the long top bar (D) into the top center connector (H) until the marble pops up.
- □ Slide a short corner bar (E) onto the end of the long top bar (D) until the short corner bar (E) clicks into place.






#### Attaching the top corner bars to the posts

- $\hfill\square$  Link the corner bar (E) with the top center connector (H) onto the post (A).
- □ Insert the other long top bars (D) with the short corner bars (E) into the top center connector (H) as Step 5.
- $\hfill\square$  Link the corner bars (E) onto the posts (A).



**NOTE**: Suggested to stand on a ladder when assembling, as shown below.




#### Attaching the top bars to the support bars

- □ Link the short top bars (F) onto the fixed support bars (B).
- $\hfill\square$  Link the middle top bars (G) onto the fixed support bars (C).



#### Assembling the roof

- $\hfill\square$  Put the small canopy (I) on top.
- Insert the wire connector on the top center connector (H) into the solar plate (M). Then turn the solar plate (M) and insert it into the slot of the top center connector (H).
- □ Insert the wire connector on the top center connector (H) into the light (N).


**NOTE:** Suggested to stand on a ladder when assembling, as shown below.






## Assembling the roof

 $\hfill\square$  Place the large canopy (J) over the roof. Make sure the canopy edge is covering the tube.



# **10** Attaching the net sidewalls


- $\hfill\square$  Hang the net sidewalls (L) inside the posts, around the four sides.
- □ Secure the gazebo to the ground using the ground stakes (DD).



# Attaching the sidewalls

 $\hfill\square$  Hang the sidewalls (K) outside the posts, around the four sides.

□ Pass one end of the rope (0) around the post, tie a knot, and fix the other end to the ground using the ground stakes (DD).




# **12** Removing the canopy

□ Remove the canopy from gazebo to avoid any damage in case of inclement weather such as wind, snows, stroms, or hail.



**NOTE:** Suggested to stand on a ladder when removing, as shown below.



## **Care and Cleaning**

□ Clean gently with a sponge using environmentally-friendly soap and water solution. Do not use abrasive materials, such as wire brushes, chemicals, cleansers or bleach. Do not use a pressure washer. Rinse well. Allow to air dry.
