







Safety Shelters Final Inspection Checklist

The Type 4 Seal from the National Storm Shelter Association will not be affixed to the Shelter unless a properly completed Inspection Checklist has been provided to the manufacturer. This checklist shall be completed by the approved inspector of the shelter. An approved inspector will consist of one of the following:

- a. the local Building Inspector, or
- b. the local Authority Having Jurisdiction (AHJ), or
- c. a Licensed Professional Inspector, or
- d. a Professional Architect or Engineer, or
- e. a Producer Member or his designate.

This document is to be used after the Assembly and Installation of your ESP Safety Shelter. It is an integral part of the Quality Assurance Plan. It must be completed for every installation to ensure your shelter is built per the manufacturer's instructions and so that the installation meets or exceeds all regulation and recommendations put forth by the National Storm Shelter Association (NSSA), FEMA P-320 and ICC-500. Each item on the checklist must be dated and initialed as it is completed.
