

- 3. Use the long end of the allen wrench to fasten allen bolts loosely and quickly.
- 4. Use the short end of the allen wrench for fin al tightening.
- 5. Do not tighten bolts completely unit all bolts are completely lined up and inserted into holes / nuts.





Assembly


1 Attaching the Headboard Legs

 Begin assembly by attaching the Headboard Legs (B) to Headboard (A) using 3Allen Bolts (BB), 3 Spring Washers (HH) and 3 Flat Washers (II) from the back of the leg.
Tighten all bolts with Allen Wrench (DD) provided.

2 Attaching the Rails to the Headboard


Attach Side Rails (D) onto Headboard Legs (B) with 2 Bolts (AA) 2 Flat Washers (II) from the front and 2 Flat Washers (II), 2 Spring Washers (HH) and 2 Nuts (CC) from the back. Tighten all bolts with Allen Wrench (DD) provided Secure bolts from back with 2 Flat Washers (II), 2 Spring Washers(HH) and 2 Nuts (CC). Tighten Nuts (CC) with Open Wrench (EE) provided..



Assembly (continued)


3 Attaching the Adjustable Feet

□ Attach the Adjustable Feet (FF) to the Support Legs (F) by screwing them into place.




4 Attaching the Support Legs

 Next attach the Support Legs (F) to the Slats (C) using 1 Al Bolt (AA) from the top of each slat. Tighten bolts with Allen Wrench (DD) provided.




5 Attaching the Footboard Feet

□ Attach Feet (G) to Footboard (E) using 1 Allen Bolt (BB), 1 Spring Washer (HH) and 1 Flat Washer (II) per foot. Tighten all bolts with Allen Wrench (DD) provided.




6 Attaching the Rails to the Footboard

Attach Footboard (E) to Rails (D) using 2 Allen Bolts (AA), 2
Spring Washers (HH) and 2 Flat Washers (II) per side. Tighten all bolts with Allen Wrench (DD) provided.

Maintenance

- Keep the product away from direct heat and sunlight.
- Prolonged exposure to heat sources may cause glazing, melting and scorching, or even cause color to fade.
- □ Regular vacuuming or light brushing helps to remove dirt and prevent soil build-up, which increases the appearance wear.
- □ Periodically (every 90 days) make sure that the screws are fully tightened.

Care and Cleaning

- Vacuum your product regularly. Small dust particles are very abrasive and can wear furniture prematurely.
- □ Clean spills immediately to prevent staining. If necessary, gently wipe away the spill using a soft, clean cloth dampened with lukewarm water. Allow to dry and brush lightly.
- Never use harsh chemicals or solvents on your product as this may damage the fabric.
- □ If you choose to use a professional product, pretest the fabric in an inconspicuous area for any signs of discoloration or shrinking.
- Marks and stains from pens, crayons and ink markers are difficult to remove. In the event that your product becomes permanently stained, we recommend that you consult a professional.
