

# **Safety Information**

# READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE YOU BEGIN INSTALLATION...

- Observe all local plumbing and building codes.
- 2. Shut off the hot and cold-water supplies.
- 3. Inspect the drain and supply tubing. Replace if necessary.
- Prior to installation, unpack the new sink and inspect it for damage. Return the sink to its protective carton until you are ready to install it.
- 5. It is very important that the proper materials are used with your sink. Proper selection of surrounding materials, such as tile and counters, is critical for a secure installation. Because of the variance in material thickness, your carpenter, tiler, and plumber maintain communication and discuss the requirements of the project.
- 6. To ensure a safe and damage-free installation, two people should install the sink.
- Due to the variety of installations possible with this sink, you
  may need to use procedures other than those described.
  Please consult a professional prior to doing so.



**NOTE:** Cabinet and frame shown in these instructions are generic and may not represent the actual design or structure.

 Due to the nature of undercounter installations, Glacier Bay recommends that undercounter sink installations, this includes apron-front sinks, be performed by trained and experienced installers.

## Warranty

#### LIFETIME LIMITED WARRANTY

### WHAT IS COVERED

Glacier Bay warrants this fireclay kitchen sink manufactured after 2012, to be free of defects in material and workmanship during normal residential use for as long as the original consumer purchaser owns their home. This warranty applies to only Glacier Bay fireclay kitchen sinks installed in the United States of America, Canada, or Mexico (North America). If a defect is found in normal residential use, Glacier Bay will, at its election, repair, replace, or make appropriate adjustment. Proof of purchase (original sales receipt) must be provided to Glacier Bay with all warranty claims. Glacier Bay is not responsible for labor charges, installation, or other incidental or consequential costs. In no event shall the liability of Glacier Bay exceed the purchase price of the product.

If the fireclay kitchen sink is used commercially or is installed outside of North America, Glacier Bay warrants the fireclay kitchen sink to be free from defects in material and workmanship for one (1) year from the date the product is installed, with all other terms of this warranty applying except duration. All other components other than the fireclay component carry Glacier Bay's one-year limited warranty unless otherwise specified.

Also include your original invoice.

#### WHAT IS NOT COVERED

Gloss reduction, scratching, staining and acid or alkaline etching of finish over time due to use, cleaning practices, or water, or atmospheric conditions, are not manufacturing defects but are indicative of normal wear and tear. Damage caused by accident, misuse, or abuse, such as dents and scratches after installation, is not covered by this warranty. Improper care and cleaning will void the warranty.



## Installation

# **1** Preparation

**Undercounter Installation:** 


- □ Check to see if the faucet can be completely assembled to the countertop and the sink.
- Determine this by taking the countertop thickness, plus the sink rim thickness, 5/8 in. (1.6 cm) plus or minus 1/32 in. (1 mm), and comparing that measurement to the available shank length between the base of the faucet assembly and the mounting nut. If the available shank length is the same or longer than needed, proceed. If not, select a thinner countertop or another faucet.

# 2 Cabinet/Support Frame Construction


- Measure the size of the sink, including the apron (the top of the apron is approximately ¼ in. (6 mm) wider than the top). The cabinet opening should equal the maximum sink/apron dimensions to ensure a minimum gap between the sink and the cabinet.
- Determine if the sink will be flush with, or extend slightly beyond the front of the cabinet. The sink may extend no more than 1-1/4 in. (3.2 cm) beyond the face of the cabinet.
- Construct a wood support frame to fit inside the cabinet opening. Allow adequate clearance for the water supply lines between the support and the finished wall.
- Locate and cut out the drain outlet clearance hole in the support. The hole diameter must clear the garbage disposal mounting system, if used.




**NOTE:** If the sink is not available at the time of installation, make allowances to add wood filler strips or spacers to the cabinet opening after the frame and before the sink is installed.

# 3 Support Frame Installation

**Undercounter and Solid Surface Installations:** 


 Position the support frame in the cabinet opening so when installed, the top of the sink will be level and flush with the top of the cabinet (Dimension H).


#### All installations:

 Secure the support frame to the cabinet. Position the securing hardware to allow for easy removal should the sink need to be removed or replaced.



**CAUTION:** Ensure that the securing hardware will not penetrate through the cabinet walls.





# 4 Undercounter/Solid Surface Preparation



**CAUTION:** Risk of personal injury or product damage. Large sinks are very heavy. Get help lifting the sink into place.



**NOTE:** Instructions in this section are for both undercounter and solid surface installation. Any differences are noted in the text.



NOTE: If using shims additional sealant will be needed.

- Use shims to level the sink if needed.
- Verify that the sink will fit in the cabinet opening. If necessary, adjust the opening by sanding the opening, or adding wood-filler strips.
- For solid surface installation, install the faucet to the sink according to the manufacturer's instructions. Install the strainer or garbage disposal to the sink according to the manufacturer's instructions.
- Apply a 1 in. (2.5 cm) spot of sealant at each corner of the frame where it will contact the sink.
- Carefully position the sink within the frame, making sure to center the sink in the cabinet.
- OPTIONAL: Apply sealant between the cabinet and the apron.
- Verify that the sink is level. The top of the sink should be flush with the top of the cabinet to allow proper countertop installation. Adjust or shim between the sink and support if needed.
- Due to the various cutout sizes possible, a template is not supplied.
- Carefully measure the countertop to determine the exact location of the cutout.
- Carefully mark the cutout location on the countertop.

## **Maintenance**

Proper care and cleaning of your new fireclay kitchen sink will keep it looking its best for years to come. Please follow these care and cleaning guides to ensure best results.

# **Care and Cleaning**

- Always test your cleaning products on an inconspicuous area before applying them to the entire surface.
- Wipe all surfaces clean and rinse completely with water immediately after applying cleaning solutions to avoid any unintended damage. Rinse off and dry any spray that lands on surrounding surfaces. Do not allow cleaners to soak or sit on surfaces.
- Use a soft, dampened sponge or cloth for cleaning. Never use an abrasive material like brushes or scouring pads to clean surfaces to avoid scratching.
- Rinse the sink thoroughly and wipe it dry with a soft cloth after each use to maintain top quality.
- □ When necessary, soft abrasive cleaners may be used for a deeper clean of your fireclay sink. Keep in mind, strong abrasive cleaners will scratch and dull the surface and should not be used.
- Do not store open containers of cleaners or chemicals such as acids, bleach, sodium chloride, lye, toilet bowl cleaner, or hard water stain removal products under your sink.



**NOTE:** Success with cleaners and procedures can be affected by water hardness and temperature, usage amounts, ingredient changes and conditions of the product being cleaned. As a result of these factors, Glacier Bay cannot guarantee the effectiveness of the recommendations made in this guide.

- For general cleaning of your fireclay sink:
  - Fantastik Antibacterial
  - o Heavy Duty Formula 409
  - Antibacterial AllPurpose
  - o Green Works All-Purpose
  - Soft Scrub Gel with Bleach
  - Soft Scrub Lemon Cleanser
- □ To remove Rust Build-up on your fireclay sink:
  - Bar Keepers Friend
  - Super Iron Out Rust Stain Remover
  - For care of Chrome and other Finish Metal Surfaces (such as the grid), do not use cleaners containing ammonia, bleach or acid. Rinse thoroughly and use a soft cloth to wipe the product dry after each use.
  - Finishes always look their best when any water is blotted dry from the surface. Allowing it to air dry may leave water deposits and spots. Always use a dabbing method to dry the surface, and never an abrasive, or rubbing action to avoid scratching on grids in particular. We recommend using a damp sponge or gentle cleaning cloth.
