

READ and UNDERSTAND this manual completely before using Utility Dump Cart.

Operator must read and understand all safety and warning information, operating instructions, maintenance and storage instructions before operating this equipment. Failure to properly operate and maintain the utility dump cart could result in serious injury to the operator or bystanders.

Operation Warnings

- Do not at any time carry passengers sit or stand on the cart.
- Do not allow children to play on, stand upon or climb in the cart.
- Always inspect the cart before using to assure it is in good working condition.
- Replace or repair damaged or worn parts immediately.
- Always check and tighten hardware and assembled parts before operation.
- Do not exceed equipment maximum load capacity of 400lb.
- Avoid large holes and ditches when transporting loads.
- Be careful when operating on steep grades (hill) the cart may tip over.
- Always operate at reduce speed in rough terrain, along creeks, ditches and on hillsides.
- Do not operate close to creeks, ditches and public highways.
- To avoid personal injury and/or equipment damage DO NOT EXCEED 10MPH.
- Always use caution when loading and unloading the cart.
- Only tow with recommended vehicles (Lawn/Garden Tractors and ATVs).
- Always secure and lock dump cart to the vehicle hitch before operating.

Crush and Cut Hazards

- Always keep hands and feet clear from moving parts while operating the equipment.
- Always clear and keep work area clean when operating.
- Always wear safety gear, eye protection, gloves and work boots when operating the dump cart.

Assembly Is Required


ABOUT YOUR UTILITY DUMP CART

This utility dump cart has a rugged steel construction and is designed to carry a wide range of materials. The dump cart will easily haul up to 400lbs of tools, firewood, animal feed, trash, landscaping materials, cement or anything else that needs to moved. Easy to use removable tailgate makes loading and un-loading fast and convenient. Never exceed the rated load capacity of 400lbs when operating the utility dump cart.

Technical specifications on the utility dump cart are provided in the "Specifications" section of this manual.

Controls and Features Identification

Read this owner's manual before operating the equipment. Familiarize yourself with the location and function of the controls and features. Save this manual for future reference.



- 1) **Removable Tailgate** Push up to remove for loading or unloading.
- 2) Utility Cart Box Do not exceed rated load capacity 400lb.
- 3) Tires / Wheel Do not exceed the recommended rate 25 PSI.
- 4) Hitch Pin-type design use only with approve vehicles.
- 5) Release Pedal Release the cart bed.



UTILITY DUMP CART COMPONENT PARTS AND ASSEMBLY


Take all parts out of the shipping crate and inspect components to ensure there are no missing pieces before starting to assemble the utility dump cart follow steps 1 through 11.





Assembly Instructions


STEP 1: Attach the Axle Support

1. Lay down the bottom panel assembly on a flat surface, remove the two M6 wing nuts (#33) on the wheel axle supports to release wheel axle supports, wing nuts need to reinstall after releasing wheel axle support.




STEP 2: Attach Tongue Support

 Turn up the wheel axle support and reinstall the M6 wing nuts (#33). Attach the tongue support (#27) to the back of the bottom panel, pay attention to the orientation of the hole on tongue support, hole should be oriented as shown below. Install four sets of M6x16 screws (#3), Ø6 lock washers (#4) and M6 hex nuts (#5), tighten all hardware when cart is turned upright.




STEP 3: Attach the Hitch Tongue Assembly

 Line up protrusion on tongue with hole on tongue support, slightly pull the foot pedal (#4) back into a released position and lock while protrusion stick in place, see DETAIL A. Insert axle (#17) into wheel axle support and tongue.




STEP 4: Attach the Wheels

1. Add one Ø16 flat washer (#14) on one side of axle, put the wheel (#15) on ensuring the nipple is outward as shown below, and then put on another Ø16 flat washer (#14), lock by Ø3 R pin (#16). Repeat on the other wheel.




STEP 5: Attach Hitch Pin Bracket

Attach two hitch pin brackets (#23) and connecting plate (#8) to the hitch tongue (#19) using two sets of M8x30 hex bolts (#18), Ø8 lock washers (#12) and M8 hex nuts (#13). Insert the hitch pin (#24) through the tongue hole and secure with Ø3 R pin (#16)




STEP 6: Attach Side Panel

1. Attach the side panel (#2) to the bottom panel (#1) using three sets of M6x16 screws (#3), Ø6 lock washers (#4) and M6 hex nuts (#5). Repeat on the other side panel.




STEP 7: Attach the Front Panel

- 1. Attach the front panel (#28) to the bottom panel using four sets of M6x16 screws (#3), Ø6 lock washers (#4) and M6 hex nuts (#5).
- 2. Attach the front panel (#28) to the side panels using six sets of M6x16 screws (#3), Ø6 lock washers (#4) and M6 hex nuts (#5).




STEP 8: Attach the Corner Plate

1. Attach the two corner plates (#29) to the side panels and front panel using four sets of M6x16 screws (#3), Ø6 lock washers (#4) and M6 hex nuts (#5).




STEP 9: Attach the U-frame

- 1. Attach the U-frame (#7) to the bottom panel and side panels using six sets of M6x16 screws (#3), Ø6 lock washers (#4) and M6 hex nuts (#5).
- 2. Attach the two rear card slots (#6) to the U-frame (#7) and both side panels using four sets of M6x16 screws (#3), Ø6 lock washers (#4) and M6 hex nuts (#5).




STEP 10: Attach the Rear Panel

1. Slide the rear panel (#9) through the rear card slots on the back side panels.



STEP 11: Attach the Card Slot and Lock Support Tube

- 1. Insert the Ø3 R Pin (#16) into the safety pin on the hitch tongue.
- 2. Pull out the Ø3 R Pin (#16) before emptying the bed and then press the release pedal.



Operation Instructions

WARNING

Before using the utility dump cart, review the instructions below and safety information. Failure to follow these instructions may result in property damage or injury to the operator or bystanders.

USING YOUR UTILITY DUMP CART

- 1. DO NOT exceed rated capacity of 400lb (182kg).
- 2. ALWAYS secure and lock the utility cart to the vehicle hitch before operating.
- 3. ONLY use approved vehicles when towing the dump cart (Lawn/Garden Tractors and ATVs)
- 4. **NEVER** tow the utility dump cart with box raised.
- 5. **DO NOT** over fill the utility dump cart. Over flow loads can cause the cart and towing vehicle to lose traction and skid out of control.
- 6. **ONLY** fill the dump cart to a comfortable dumping load. Extremely heavy loads will be difficult to operate and dump.
- 7. ALWAYS use the dump cart for its intended purpose.
- 8. **ALWAYS** make sure that the tow vehicle and the combined weight of the operator MUST BE greater than the load of the cart weight for proper control.
- 9. DO NOT use cart on public highways or roads.
- 10. **NEVER** exceed 10mph when towing the dump cart.
- 11. **DO NOT** make sharp turns that may cause the Lawn/Garden Tractor or ATV tires to rub against the utility dump cart.
- 12. ALWAYS slow down before turning.
- 13. **ALWAYS** use caution when backing the utility cart. To avoid the cart from "jack-knifing" always back up in a straight line.

Maintenance and Storage

WARNING

Improper maintenance and storage of the utility dump cart may void your warranty.

MAINTENANCE

- After each use clean material out of the cart box.
- Rinse/dry inside and outside of the dump cart after each use.
- Before operating make sure the tires have the RECOMMENDED TIRE PRESSURE 25 PSI.
- Regularly grease the axle and the wheel bearing area or when needed.
- Periodically check all fasteners for tightness.
- Annually clean and lightly lubricate parts.
- Use a glossy enamel spray paint to touch up scratched or worn painted metal surfaces.
- Never exceed load capacity rating of 400lb (182kg) it will damage the utility dump cart.

IMPORTANT:


If a part needs replacement, only use parts that meet the manufacturer's specifications. Replacement parts that do not meet specifications may result in a safety hazard or poor operation.

STORAGE

- Never allow material to remain in the utility dump cart for extended periods of time.
- Before storing make sure the cart is clean and dry for years of trouble free service.
- Store indoors or protected area during severe weather and winter months.
- When storing outside always keep the tongue a little higher than the back of the cart to allow the moister to easily run out the back and will not accumulate in the box.

<u>Warranty</u>

For two year from the date of purchase YTL International will replace for the original purchaser, or repair the utility dump cart. The warranty will not apply to any unit which was not assembled correctly, misused, overloaded or which has been used or operated contrary to our instructions, or which has been repaired or altered by anyone other than an authorized representative.

Warranty Exclusions

This warranty does not cover cosmetic defects such as paint, decals or wear items such as tires. This warranty will not cover failures or problems due to acts of God, or events or forces beyond the control of the manufacturer.

Normal Wear Exclusion

The utility dump cart needs periodic service to perform well. This warranty does not cover repair when normal use has exhausted the life of a part or the equipment as a whole.

Installation, Use and Maintenance Exclusion

This warranty will not apply to parts and/or labor if the utility dump cart has been misused, neglected, involved in an accident, abused, loaded beyond its limits, modified or assembled incorrectly. Normal maintenance is not covered under this warranty.

Limits of Implied Warranty and Consequential Damage Exclusion

YTL International disclaims any obligation to cover any loss of time, use of this product, freight, or any incidental or consequential claim by anyone from using this utility dump cart. THIS WARRANTY IS IN LIEU OF ALL OTHER WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR.

An exchange unit will be subject to the original warranty. The length of the warranty governing the exchanged unit will have the date as the purchase date of the original unit. This warranty gives you certain legal rights which may change from state to state. Your state may also have other rights you may be entitled to that are not listed within this warranty.
