## STEP 5: Attaching the Short Frames to the Post

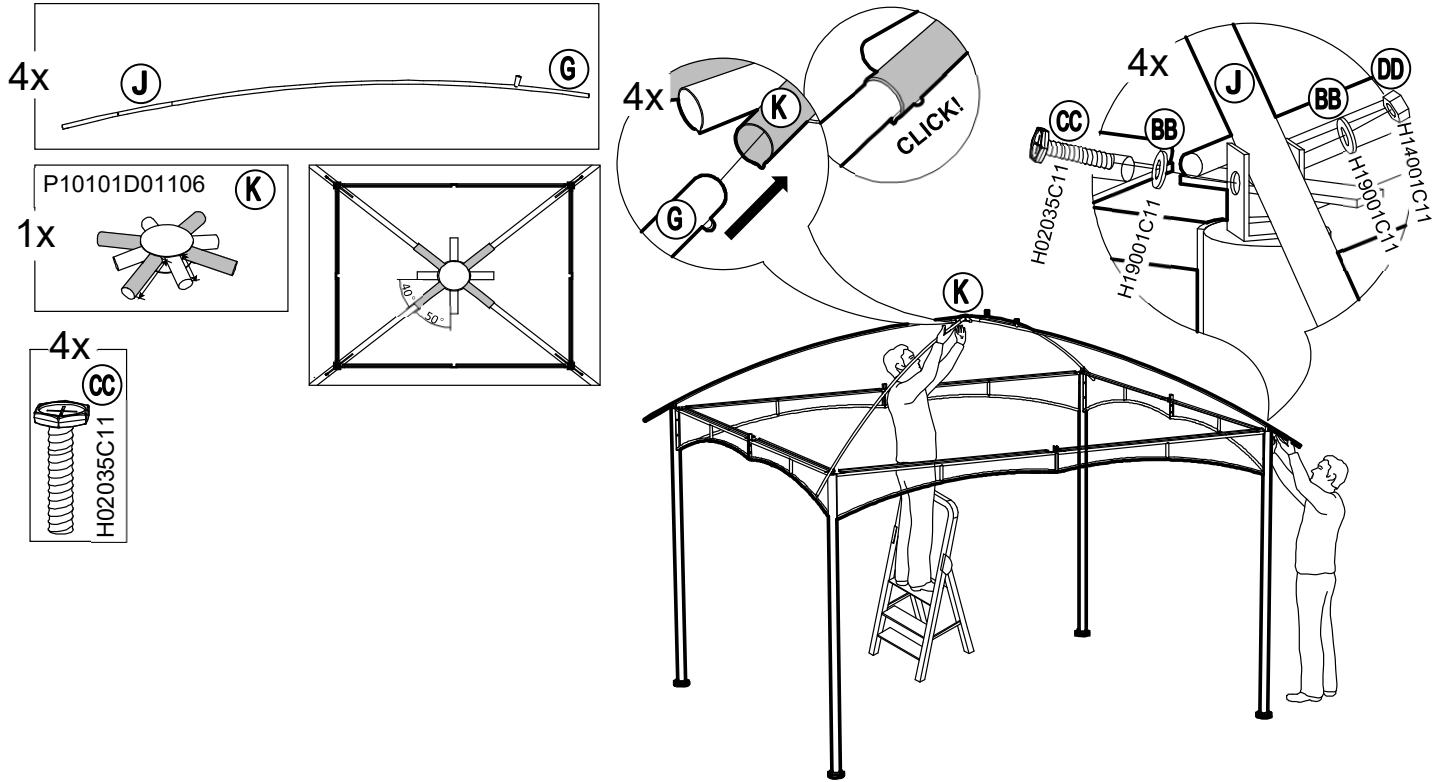


## STEP 6: Attaching the Oblique Boards

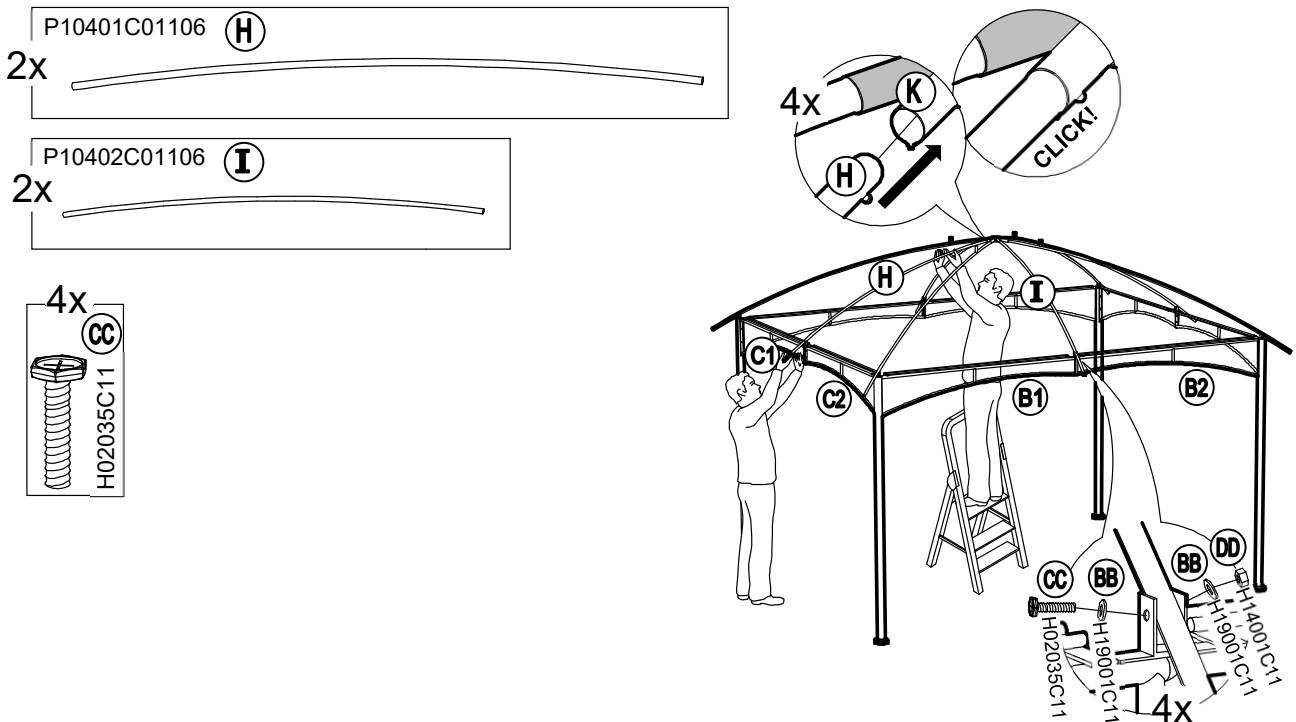
