CAUTION

- □ USE preventative cleaning measures to keep your stone pristine.
- USE sealers according to the product specific directions.
- □ Blot spills quickly, and wash with mild soap and warm water.
- □ Stone countertops (Granite, Marble, etc.) are surprisingly resilient to stains and scratches. However, as a preventative measure, any spills on the stone surfaces should be wiped up within a reasonable amount of time. Don't let liquid sit on the stone overnight. Stones are most prone to staining by oil and acid, so be sure to blot these spills up as soon as they happen. Follow up by cleaning the stone with a mild non-abrasive soap and water.
- Be sure to check all packing materials carefully for small parts that may have come loose inside the carton during shipment. If parts are missing, contact THE HOME DEPOT to obtain any missing parts.
- Using abrasive cleansers will damage the surface.

Assembly


Adjustable Level

In case of uneven floors, floor levelers are provided at the bottom of the vanity. If necessary, adjust floor levelers by hand to correct tilting and/or level doors.



2 Backsplash Installation

To mount the backsplash (C) to the wall, apply a thin bead of silicone compound (not included) to the unpolished back side and bottom of the backsplash (C). Position backsplash (C) as shown onto vanity top (A) and against the wall. Clean any excess silicone compound before allowing to dry.





3 Vanity Drawer Removal

- □ Removing the Drawer:
- 1. Unload the contents from the drawer.
- 2. Slide out the drawer as far as it will go.
- Press the lever down on the right-hand track and lift the lever up or the left track to release the drawer. Pull the drawer out the rest of the way.
- □ Replacing the Drawer:
- 1. Align the drawer guides with the receiving glides.
- 2. Hold the receiving glides firmly and insert the drawer guide.


NOTE: It is normal for the drawer to close tightly the first time after it has been removed.

3. Push the drawer in completely.



4 Hinge Adjustment For Door Alignment


- ☐ If the doors preassembled to vanity base (B) require adjustment, follow the below options as needed:
- □ To adjust door up or down, loosen screws (a), adjust door and retighten screws.
- □ To adjust door left and right, turn screw (b) in or out.
- To adjust door in and out, loosen screw (c), adjust door and retighten screw.


Water Supply Lines Guide


Mark wall for vanity placement and note the location of the water supply lines and drain on the back panel of vanity.



2 Drain Installation Guide

- ☐ Move vanity (B) into proper place against the wall.
- □ Install faucet, drain and supply lines (none included) to vanity top (A) according to the instructions supplied with those items.





Maintenance

Tips for using touch-up pen (AA): For scratches, stroke in direction of scratch; for worn areas, stroke in direction of wood grain. Rub excess colorant promptly with a soft cloth.

Care and Cleaning

- □ Rinse vanity top with clean, hot water frequently.
- □ Blot spills quickly, and wash with mild soap and warm water.
- □ Clean the surface with a glass cleaner or other household cleansers that are non-abrasive
- □ Remove oil-based stains with acetone, mineral spirits, or ammonia.
- Organic stains like coffee, tea, or juice can be removed with hydrogen peroxide, mixed with a few drops of ammonia
- □ Water spots or rings can be removed by buffing the spots gently with 00-gauge steel wool.
- □ Small nicks and scratches can often be removed the same way.
- □ Larger scratches, chips, and resilient stains may require professional help. Please contact your local stonemason for details.
- Use if you have Natural Stone Your stone was sealed at the factory, but reapplication is necessary over time. How often is determined by the quality of the sealer used, and the frequency of use. We recommend using a penetrating non-toxic sealer for bath areas.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Corrective Action
Vanity doors rub against another surface.	The floor is not level.	 Adjust the leg levelers to ensure the vanity combo is level. Adjust the door hinges.
There is an uneven gap between the doors and cabinet.	The floor is not level.	 Adjust the leg levelers to ensure the vanity combo is level. Adjust the door hinges.
