

WARNING: FOR OUTDOOR USE ONLY! NEVER LEAVE A FIRE UNATTENED!



WARNING: DO NOT USE THE FIRE PIT TO COOK FOOD! The fire pit is not designed for grilling food.



WARNING: DO NOT allow children or pets near fire pit without supervision.



WARNING: DO NOT touch the surface of the fire pit while in use as it may cause burns.



WARNING: NEVER burn in vehicles, tents or indoors. CARBON MONOXIDE HAZARD.



WARNING: Use a poker and/ or heatresistant gloves to open/close the mesh cover while in use.



WARNING: DO NOT use water to extinguish as this is dangerous and can cause damage to the fire pit.



CAUTION: Burn only untreated wood or fire logs in this fire pit.



CAUTION: DO NOT use gasoline or kerosene to start the fire in this fire pit.



CAUTION: DO NOT use this unit on a wood deck, long or dry grass and/or leaves, or on combustible surfaces.



CAUTION: DO NOT attempt to move the fire pit while it is hot or in use.



CAUTION: Place the fire pit no closer than 8 ft. from walls or combustibles during use.



CAUTION: Adequate fire extinguishing material should be readily available.



CAUTION: Always ensure that the mesh cover is secured over the fire bowl while in use.



CAUTION: The poker handle may become hot during and after use.


PLANNING ASSEMBLY





Assembly


1 Assembling the mesh cover


- ☐ Insert the handle (A) into the hole of the chimney cover (B).
- ☐ Attach the handle (A) to the chimney cover (B) using a nut (DD). Securely tighten with an M6 wrench (not included).


Wear gloves during assembly.





2 Assembling the stand


- ☐ Attach the stands (G) to the tray (H) using M6 x 10 mm bolts (AA).
- ☐ Hand tighten the bolts (AA). Do not over-tighten.



Assembly (continued)


Attaching the chimney bottom

- ☐ Attach the chimney bottom (F) to the stand (G) using M6 x 12 mm bolts (BB).
- ☐ Securely tighten each bolt (BB) with a Philips screwdriver (not included).



4 Attaching the mesh screen


- ☐ Attach the mesh screen (E) to chimney bottom (F) using M6 x 25 mm bolts (CC) and M6 nuts (DD).
- ☐ Securely tighten each bolt (CC) and nut (DD) with an M6 wrench and Philips screwdriver (not included).



Assembly (continued)


5 Attaching the chimney top

- ☐ Attach the chimney top (D) to the chimney flue (C) using M6 x 10 mm bolts (AA).
- ☐ Securely tighten each bolt (AA) with a Philips screwdriver (not included).



6 Attaching the chimney flue


- ☐ Attach the chimney top (D) to the mesh screen (E) using M6 x 25 mm bolts (CC) and M6 nuts (DD).
- ☐ Securely tighten each bolt (CC) and nut (DD) with an M6 wrench and Philips screwdriver (not included).



7 Completing the assembly


☐ Place the poker (I) near the chimney and the chimney cover (B) on the top of the assembly.


