

Using vinegar is a great economical way to clean your home. The uses are endless and these listed below are but a few common applications. Refer to equipment manufacturer's or information websites for your specific application needs.

DIRECTIONS: Always dilute 1/2 cup of this product with a gallon of water prior to use. When cleaning with any product, always test in an inconspicuous area to ensure there is no damage or discoloration. Do not use on marble, granite or natural stone surfaces as they may dull, etch or stain.

Laundry Use

To remove stains

DO NOT use on acetate fibers

Dosage

Full

Instructions

Remove clothing stains by rubbing the stain softly with vinegar then laundering as normal. Fresh stains are easier to remove than dried-on stains.

Cleaning and Deodorizing

KITCHEN: Cleaning and deodorizing counter tops, garbage cans, garbage disposals, sinks and drains

BATHROOM: Effective at removing hard water stains, odors, soap scum from stainless steel, ceramic, tubs, toilets and showers

1/2 cup

1 Gallon

Use full strength and allow to dry.

Odor Removal

Garbage cans and drains

1/2 cup

1 Gallon

Place 1/2 cup vinegar overnight in the desired location to fight tough odors.

Equipment

Can be used to remove stains and clean coffee machines, humidifiers and washing machines
