| Issue | Cause | Solution |

| Appliance doesn't turn on. | The plug is positioned incorrectly in the wall outlet. The dehydrator switch is not in the ON position. | Remove from outlet and plug in again. Flip the switch to the ON position. |
| Heater is working but the fan is not working. | Check for any foreign objects stuck in the fan. | Turn appliance off and remove foreign object. If fan still does not work, contact customer service. |
| Fan is working but there is not heat. | Heater Malfunction | Turn the appliance off and contact customer service. |
| Over heating or little heating. | Temperature control system control not working properly. | Turn the appliance off and contact customer service. |
| Not dehydrating. | Too much food on the tray. Food is overlapping on the tray. | Reduce the food quantity. Evenly space food on the tray. |
| Foods are not evenly dehydrated. | The thickness of the food is not even. Too much food on the tray. | Evenly slice and space the food. Reduce the food on the tray. |
| Moisture on the door. | Too much food on the tray. Food contains too much water. | Reduce the food quantity. Reduce the food quantity and increase dehydrating time. |
| Unusual sound from fan. | Screen cover in front of fan is rubbing the fan blade. | Turn OFF the appliance and unplug from the wall outlet. Carefully pull the screen away from the fan blades by using needle nose pliers. |
