
Assembly

Inserting the Cam bolts

☐ Insert the Cam bolts (GG) in the Right panel (#3).



NOTE: To avoid destroying the finish, do not put the parts on the ground directly.




2 Assembling the Towel bar

☐ Connect the Towel bar holders (#7) with the Towel bar (#8).



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


3 Connecting the Towel bar

□ Connect the assembled Towel bar holder (#7) with the right panel (#3) using Screws (BB). Tighten with Hex key (JJ).



NOTE: To avoid destroying the finish, do not put the parts on the ground directly.




4 Inserting the Cam bolts

☐ Insert the Cam bolt (GG) in the Left panel (#2).





Assembly (continued)

5 Attaching the Back panel and Upper shelf

□ Attach the Back panel (#4) to the Left panel (#2) using Wooden pins (DD) and Screws (CC). Insert the Upper panel (#5) into the Cam bolts (GG) on the Left panel (#2) to connect with the panel. Secure together using the Cams (HH).




6 Attaching the Bottom shelf

☐ Insert the Wooden pins (DD) on the Left panel (#2), then connect the Bottom shelf (#6) with the Left panel (#2) using Flat washers (FF), Spring washers (EE) and Bolts (AA). Tighten with Hex key (JJ).



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


7 Attaching the Right panel

Repeat step 5 and step 6 to attach the Right panel (#3).



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


8 Attaching the Caster wheels

☐ Insert the Caster wheels (LL&MM) on the bottom of the side panels (#2 & #3).



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
Assembly (continued)

Attaching the Table top

☐ Insert the Wooden pins (DD) on the side panel (#2 & #3), then place the Table top (#1) on the assembled body.



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


10 Securing the Table top

☐ Secure the Table top (#1) with the side panels (#2 & #3) using Screws (CC).



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


11 Attaching the Side drawer panel

☐ Connect the Side drawer panels (#10 & #11) with the Back drawer panel (#12) using Screws (CC).



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


12 Attaching the Bottom drawer panel

☐ Insert the Bottom drawer panel (#13) into the assembled drawer body.




 $\ensuremath{\text{NOTE:}}$ To avoid destroying the finish, do not put the parts on the ground directly.



Assembly (continued)

13 Attaching the Front drawer panel and the Handle

Attach the Front drawer panel (#9) to the Side drawer panels (#10) using Screws (CC). Then attach the Handle (II) on the Front drawer panel (#9) using Bolts (KK).




14 Placing the Drawer

☐ Place the assembled drawer onto the chain and close it.



NOTE: To avoid destroying the finish, do not put the parts on the ground directly.



Care and Cleaning

- □ When not in use, store in a cool, dry area.
